# Confetti Glass

Triangular Shawl

## Materials

Hobbii Friends Cotton Silk

### Shades:

**Yarn A:** #33; 2 skeins

**Yarn B:** #57; 2 skeins

**Yarn C:** #63; 2 skeins

4.00mm / US G crochet hook

Always use a hook size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

## Yarn Quality

 **Friends Cotton Silk**, Hobbii

Light Worsted, DK

77% Cotton, 23% Silk

50 g (1.75 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

## Gauge

15 dc & 9 rows = 10cm / 4" over crochet pattern using 4mm hook after blocking.

## Measurements

### Finished Measurements:

130cm / 51" wingspan, 55cm / 21½" deep at centre spine

## Pattern Information

Confetti Glass is constructed from the top down. The shawl begins with a magic ring and is worked outwards to expand the wingspan row by row. Colors are changed on each row while crocheting over ends to avoid many tails to weave in at the end.

## Pattern



**US crochet terminology used throughout.**

### Abbreviations

**ch:** chain

**ch-sp:** chain space

**dc:** double crochet

**inc:** increase/s/d/ing

**st(s):** stitch(es)

### PATTERN BEGINS

**Note:** It is recommended to crochet over your tails to avoid weaving in many ends.

Using Yarn A, make a magic ring.

**Row 1:** Ch3 (counts as st throughout), 2dc, ch2, 3dc into magic ring, turn. *6dc*

Close magic ring by pulling the tail to tighten your circle. Cut yarn leaving 15cm / 6" tail and fasten off.

**Row 2:** With Yarn B, ch3, 2dc into same st, dc in each st to ch2-sp, [dc, ch2, dc] into ch2-sp, dc into each st to end, 3dc into ch3. Turn. *6dc inc*

Cut yarn leaving 15cm / 6" tail and fasten off.

**Row 3:** With Yarn C, ch3, 2 dc into same st, dc in each st to ch2-sp, [dc, ch2, dc] into ch2-sp, dc into each st to end, 3dc into ch3. Turn. *6dc inc*

Cut yarn leaving 15cm / 6" tail and fasten off.

**Row 4:** With Yarn A, ch3, 2dc into same st, dc in each st to ch2-sp, [dc, ch2, dc] into ch2-sp, dc into each st to end, 3dc into ch3. Turn. *6dc inc*

Cut yarn leaving 15cm / 6" tail and fasten off.

Rep rows 2-4 a further 13 times. *258dc*

## FINISHING

### Tassels (make 26):

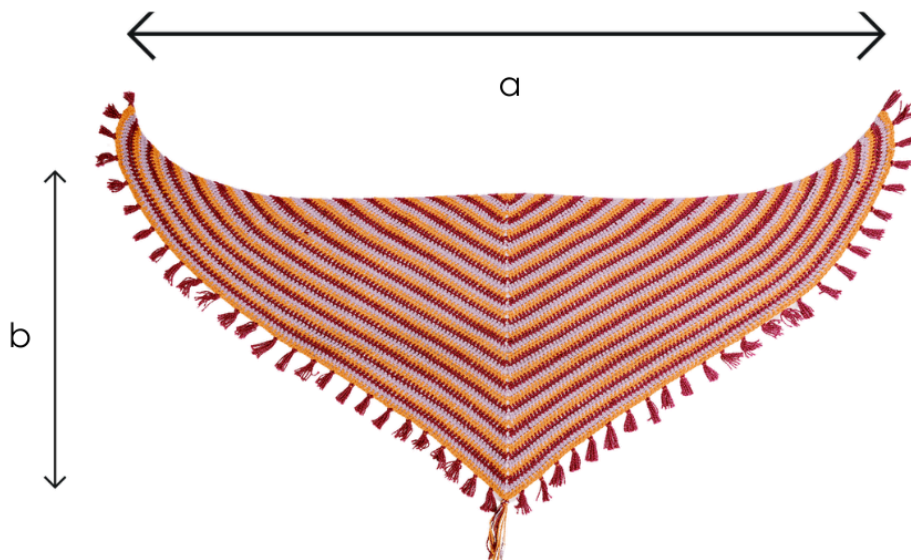
Cut six 10cm / 4" lengths of yarn for each tassel.

Attach tassels every 5<sup>th</sup> st along last row of shawl as follows: fold the bundle of yarn in half, insert the folded end through the centre of the st using hook, then draw the loose ends through the loop.

Weave in ends and block.
