MATERIALS

Friends Ribbon

3 skeins of color 122

1 skein of color 123

Scrap white cotton yarn (optional)

Crochet hook 8 mm / US L-11

Felt base (30 cm diameter)

Yarn needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Ribbon**, Hobbii

100 % Cotton

250 g / 8.8 oz = 125 m / 136 yds

GAUGE

10 sts x 13 rows = 7 cm x 9 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

st = stitch

sts = stitches

sl st = slip stitch

mr = magic ring

inc = increase

dec = decrease

flo = front loop only

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 30 cm (11.8")

Height: 16 cm (6.3")

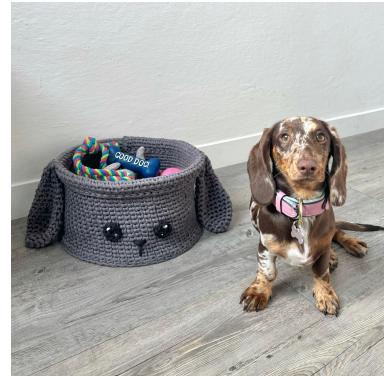

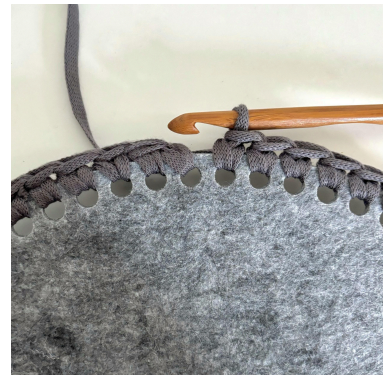
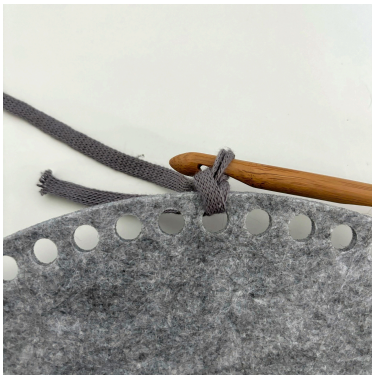

Pattern



BASKET

Round 1: pull up a loop from one of the holes in your felt base and sc all around.



Once you get back to the first ch, join the round following these steps:

1. Remove the hook from the loop.



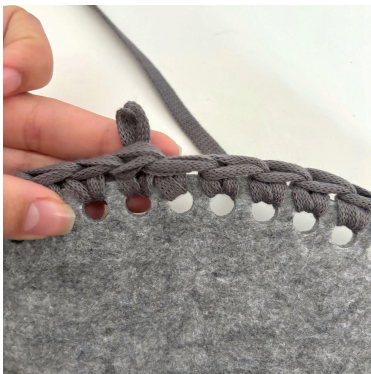
2. Reinsert the hook in the first sc of the round.



3. Take the loop and pull through the first sc stitch.



4. Remove the hook from the loop.



5. Reinsert your hook in the last stitch of the round.



6. Take the loop and slip stitch flo. Ch 1.



Round 2: sc all around in the third loop of every stitch.
*Note: the third loop is in the back of every single stitch.





To join the round sl st in the first sc and ch 1.

Rounds 3-25: split sc 68, sl st to join the round, ch 1.



*Note: To split single crochet, insert your hook between the V shape in front, instead of the normal placement.



Fasten off and weave in the end.

To make our basket sturdy we'll need to make a brim in the opening.



Align the last row of your basket with the space between row 18 and 19 creating a fold. Insert your hook in a stitch in row 25 and pull up a loop in anywhere between row 18 and 19 securing the fold in place. Surface crochet all around.



*Note: To surface crochet, insert the hook through the desired location on the fabric, yarn over, and pull up a loop, then continue to crochet along the surface, repeating as needed.



EARS

Round 1: 6sc in mr (6)

Round 2: (sc, inc) x 3 times (9)

Round 3: (2 sc, inc) x 3 times (12)

Round 4: (3 sc, inc) x 3 times (15)

Round 5: (4 sc, inc) x 3 times (18)

Rounds 6-8: 18 sc (18)
Round 9: (4 sc, dec) x 3 times (15)
Rounds 10-11: 15 sc (15)
Round 12: (3sc, dec) x 3 times (12)
Rounds 13-14: 12 sc (12)
Round 15: (2sc, dec) x 3 times (9)
Rounds 16-18: 9 sc (9)
Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Next, flatten and pinch the ears to shape them. Sew together the bottom stitches of the ears. Then, with a yarn needle attach the ears to the top of the basket, making sure they are spaced 34 stitches apart.



FACE

Make two eyes:

Round 1: 6 sc in a mr, sl st to join the round.

Leave a long tail for sewing.

Optional: Add embroidered highlights with white yarn.

Embroider the nose between rows 7 and 8 and add a vertical line for the mouth.

Attach the eyes between rows 9 and 11, with about 4 stitches between them.
