MATERIALS

Amigo

1 skein of colour 28 – Yarn A

1 skein of colour 42 – Yarn B

1 skein of colour 02 – Yarn C

Straight needles 3.25mm (UK 10 /US 3)

2x stitch holders

sewing needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Amigo**, Hobbii

100 % Acrylic,

50 g / 0.1.75 oz = 175 m / 191 yds

GAUGE

26 sts x 30 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

SIZE

One size

To fit Ida doll 30cm /12" tall

PATTERN INFORMATION

This outfit is made for the Ida doll.

The doll pattern is available separately:

This pattern is knitted using straight knitting needles and seamed, using mattress stitch.

The Christmas dress is knitted from the top down. The sleeve sts are placed on stitch holders and knitted after completing the dress bodice and skirt. The dress and boots trim is knitted separately and sewn on. The Elf hat is knitted from the white hat band to the tip. The boots are knitted in one piece.

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = Cast on

k = knit

p = purl

kfb = knit into front and then back of the same stitch

St st = k1 row, p1 row. (Makes 2 rows) Pattern indicates whether to start with a k or p row.

C&T = Cut and thread yarn through remaining stitches. Slide stitches off the needle.

rep = repeat

BO = bind off (Cast Off)

DRESS

Cast on 26 sts using 3.25mm needles and Yarn A.

Row 1 (RS) Knit.

Row 2 K2, yo, k2tog (*Makes buttonhole*) K22. [26]

Row 3 K1, purl to last st, k1.

Row 4 K3, *kfb, K1, rep from * three times, kfb, K6, *kfb, K1, rep from * three times, kfb, K3. [34]

Row 5 K1. purl to last st, k1.

Row 6 K4, kfb, K1, kfb, K3, kfb, K1, kfb, K8, kfb, K1, kfb, K3, kfb, K1, kfb, K4. [42 sts]

Row 7 K1. purl to last st, k1.

Row 8 K5, kfb, K1, kfb, K5, kfb, K1, kfb, K10, kfb, K1, kfb, K5, kfb, K1, kfb, K5. [50]

Row 9 K1. purl to last st, k1.

Row 10 K6, kfb, K1, kfb, K7, kfb, K1, kfb, K12, kfb, K1, kfb, K7, kfb, K1, kfb, K6. [58]

Row 11 K1. purl to last st, k1.

Row 12 K7, kfb, K1, kfb, K9, kfb, K1, kfb, K14, kfb, K1, kfb, K9, kfb, K1, kfb, K7. [66]

Row13 K1. purl to last st, k1.

Row 14 K8, kfb, K1, kfb, K11, kfb, K1, kfb, K16, kfb, K1, kfb, K11, kfb, K1, kfb, K8. [74]

Row 15 K1. purl to last st, k1.

Row 16 K9, kfb, K1, kfb, K13, kfb, K1, kfb, K18, kfb, K1, kfb, K13, kfb, K1, kfb, K9. [82]

Row 17 K1. purl to last st, k1.

Row 18 K10, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K15, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K20, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K15, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K10. [90]

Row 19 K1. purl to last st, k1.

Row 20 K11, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K17, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K22, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K17, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K11. [98]

Row 21 K1. purl to last st, k1.

Row 22 Kfb14, slip next 22 sts onto a stitch holder, Kfb 26, slip next 22 sts onto a stitch holder, Kfb14. [108 sts]

You will now have 108 sts on your needle with 2 sets of 22 slipped stiches on holders which will make the sleeves.

Row 23 P27, p2tog, (to join under the sleeve) P50, p2tog, (to join under the second sleeve) P27. [106 sts]

Rows 24 to 49 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 26 rows.

Join Yarn B. *Carry unused yarn up the side of the work.*

Rows 50-51 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Use Yarn A.

Rows 52-53 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Use Yarn B

Rows 54 to 55 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Use Yarn A

Rows 56 to 57 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Use Yarn C.

Beg with a K row, work in st st for 4 rows.

Rows 58 to 61 Knit 4 rows.

Row 62 BO.

Sleeves

First Sleeve

Slip stitches from one holder onto the needle.

Join Yarn A.

Row 1-8 (RS) Beg with a K row, work in st st for 8 rows [22]

Change to Yarn B, carry Yarn A up the side of the work.

Row 9-10 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 2 rows

Use Yarn A.

Row 11-12 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 2 rows

Change to Yarn C.

Row 13-15 Knit 3 rows.

Row 16 BO.

Second sleeve

Repeat as for the first sleeve.

Dress trim

Cast on 1 st using 3.25mm needles and Yarn B.

Row 1 Kfb [2]

Row 2 Knit.

Row 3 K1, kfb [3]

Row 4 Knit.

Row 5 K2, kfb [4]

Row 6 BO3 [1]

Row 7 Slide remaining st from right to left needle without turning the work.

Rows 8-56 Rep rows 1-7 six more times (creates 7 leaves)

Row 57 BO last st.

Hat

Cast on 62 sts using 3.25mm needles and Yarn C.

Rows 1-3 Knit 3 rows.

Change to Yarn B.

Rows 4-9 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 6 rows.

Join Yarn A, carry Yarn B up the side of work.

Rows 10-15 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 6 rows.

Use Yarn B.

Rows 16-17 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Row 18 K1*k8, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [56]

Row 19-21 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 3 rows.

Use Yarn A.

Rows 22-23 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Row 24 K1*k7, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [50]

Row 25-27 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 3 rows.

Use Yarn B.

Rows 28-29 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Row 30 K1*k6, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [44]

Row 31-33 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 3 rows.

Use Yarn A.

Rows 34-35 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Row 36 K1*k5, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [38]

Row 37-39 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 3 rows.

Use Yarn B.

Rows 40-41 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Row 42 K1*k4, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [32]

Row 43-45 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 3 rows.

Use Yarn A.

Rows 46-47 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Row 48 K1*k3, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [26]

Row 49-51 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 3 rows.

Use Yarn B.

Row 52-53 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Row 54 K1*k2, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [20]

Row 55-57 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 3 rows.

Use Yarn A.

Row 58-59 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Row 60 K1*k1, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [14]

Row 61-63 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 3 rows.

Use Yarn B.

Row 64-67 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 4 rows.

Row 68 *K2tog to end of row. [7]

Row 69 C&T.

Boots

Make 2

Cast on 20 sts using 3.25mm needles and Yarn C.

Rows 1-2 Knit 2 rows.

Change to Yarn A

Rows 3 to 9 Beg with a P row, work in St st for 7 rows.

Row 10 K9, kfb twice, K9. [22 sts]

Row 11 Purl.

Row 12 K9, kfb, K2, kfb, K9. [24 sts]

Row 13 -14 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Row 15 K8, kfb eight times, K8. [32 sts]

Rows 16 to 23 Beg with a P row, work in St st for 8 rows.

Rows 24 to 26 Knit 3 rows.

Row 27 k2tog, *K1, k2tog rep from* to end of row. [21 sts]

Row 28 Knit.

Row 29 *k2tog, rep from *to last st, K1. [11 sts]

Row 30 BO.

Boot trim

Make two

Cast on 1 st using 3.25mm needles and Yarn B.

Row 1-7 rep as for Dress trim.

Slide remaining st from right to left needle without turning the work.

Rows 8-42 Rep rows 1-6 five more times. (Gives 6 leaves)

Row 43 BO last st.

MAKING UP INSTRUCTIONS

All seams are mattress stitch with wrong sides together.

Dress

Sew the back seam from the hem to the bodice. Sew in any loose ends and use the buttonholes to guide you for placing the buttons.

Sew each sleeve seam closed and use the yarn ends to sew the decorative hem together on the cuffs.

Position the red trim around the neck edge. Sew the trim into place leaving the points of the leaves free.



Sew two decorative buttons to the front of the bodice.

Lightly press or block the garment following instructions on yarn ball band.

Hat

Use the C&T yarn to gather the tip of the hat shut and then sew the seam of the hat.

Use Matching yarn C to sew the seam on the hat trim.

Make a small pompom and sew it to the tip of the hat. Place the hat on the dolls head, fold the point of the hat to the side and secure it in place with a few small stitches through the Yarn C hat trim.



Making a small pompom

Take a dinner fork and wrap yarn around the tines 20 times. Thread a length of yarn between the middle tines and around the wrapped yarn, tie tightly, and slip the yarn off the fork. Snip through the loops of yarn to create a pompom.

Boots

Fold the knitting with wrong sides together and row ends matching. Mattress Stitch the BO edge and row ends together. Weave in yarn ends.

Position the red trim immediately beneath the white rows at the top of the boot.

Sew the trim into place along the edge, leaving the points of the trim free.
