MATERIALS

Tweed Dreams

Yarn A: 1 skein of col. 20

Amigo

Yarn B: 1 skein of col. 19

Yarn C: 1 skein of col. 37

Yarn D: 1 skein of col. 01

Yarn E: 1 skein of col. 12

Straight needles 4 mm (UK 8 /US 6)

Straight needles 3.25mm (UK 10 /US 3)

Stuffing

Yarn needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Tweed Dreams**, Hobbii

100 % Acrylic

50 g / 0.1.75 oz = 100 m / 109 yds

 **Amigo**, Hobbii

100 % Acrylic,

50 g / 0.1.75 oz = 175 m / 191 yds

GAUGE

Amigo = 26sts x 30 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm /

4" x 4"

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 20cm /8"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This cute owl is knitted flat on straight knitting needles and seamed, using mattress stitch.

The Owl body is knitted in a simple textured moss stitch pattern. The Hat and cloak are knitted separately and sewn on.

The Cloak is decorated with embroidered stars.

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = Cast on

k = knit

p = purl

kfb = knit into front and then back of the same stitch (1 stitch increased)

stst = k 1 row, p 1 row. (Makes 2 rows) *Pattern indicates whether to start with a k or p row.*

ssk = slip next st knit wise, slip following stitch purl wise, Insert the tip of the left needle, from left to right, into the fronts of the 2 slipped stitches and knit them together as one stitch. (1 stitch decreased)

rep = repeat

Skp = slip one st knit wise, knit next st, pass slipped stitch over (1 stitch decreased)

YO = Yarn over Bring the yarn from the front over the right-hand needle to the back of the work, knit the next stitch. (1 stitch increased)

BO = bind off (Cast Off)

C&T = cut yarn and thread through remaining stitches. Slide stitches off needle.

R.S. = right side

k2tog = knit 2 sts together

OWL PATTERN

Body and head

Use Yarn A. Starting at base of body

Cast on 8 sts using 4mm needles.

Row 1 *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row.

R.S. Row 2 *Kfb, rep from * to end of row. [16]

Row 3 *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row.

Row 4 *K1, kfb, rep from * to end of row. [24]

Row 5 *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row.

Row 6 *P1, k1, kfb, k1, p1, kfb, rep from * to end of row. [32]

Row 7 *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row.

Row 8 *P1, k1, p1, kfb, rep from * to end of row. [40]

Row 9 *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row.

Row 10 *(P1, k1) twice, kfb, (k1, p1) twice, kfb, rep from * to end of row. [48]

Row 11 *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row.

Row 12 *(P1, k1) twice, p1, kfb, rep from * to end of row. [56]

Row 13 *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row.

Row 14 *P1, k1, rep from * to end of row.

Row 15-28 rep rows 13 & 14 seven more times.

Row 29-40 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 12 rows.

Row 41 Purl.

Row 42 *K5, k2tog, rep from * to end of row. [48]

Row 43 Purl.

Row 44 *K4, k2tog, rep from * to end of row. [40]

Row 45 Purl.

Row 46 *K3, k2tog, rep from * to end of row. [32]

Row 47 Purl.

Row 48 *K2, k2tog, rep from * to end of row. [24]

Row 49 Purl.

Row 50 *K1, k2tog, rep from * to end of row. [16]

Row 51 C&T.

Hat

Use Yarn B. Starting at tip of the hat,
Cast on 7 sts using 4mm needles.

Row 1 K1 *kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[12]

Row 2 Purl.

Row 3 K1, *k1, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[17]

Row 4 Purl.

Row 5 K1, *k2, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[22]

Row 6 Purl.

Row 7 K1, *k3, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[27]

Row 8 Purl.

Row 9 K1, *k4, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[32]

Row 10 Purl.

Row 11 K1, *k5, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[37]

Row 12 Purl.

Row 13 K1, *k6, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[42]

Row 14 Purl.

Row 15 K1, *k7, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[47]

Row 16 Purl.

Row 17 K1, *k8, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[52]

Row 18 Purl.

Row 19 K1, *k9, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[57]

Row 20 Purl.

Row 21 K1, *k10, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[62]

Row 22 Purl.

Row 23 K1, *k11, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[67]

Row 24 Purl.

Row 25 K1, *k12, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[72]

Row 26 Purl.

Row 27 K1, *k13, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[77]

Row 28 Purl.

Change to Yarn C.

Row 29-34 Beg with a K row, work in st st for 6 rows.

Change to Yarn B.

Row 35 K3, *k8, kfb, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.[85]

Row 36 Knit

Row 37 K1, *k9, kfb, rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.[93]

Row 38 Knit

Row 39 K4, *k10, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1.[101]

Row 40 Knit

Row 41 K2, *k11, kfb, rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.[109]

Row 42 BO loosely.

Beak

Use Yarn C. Starting at tip of the beak
Cast on 2 sts using 3.25mm needles.

Row 1 Kfb, k1. [3]

Row 2 Knit.

Row 3 K2, kfb. [4]

Row 4 Knit.

Row 5 Kfb, k3. [5]

Row 6 Knit.

Row 7 K4 kfb. [6]

Row 8 Knit.

Row 9 BO.

Eyes, make 2

Use Yarn D. Cast on 24 sts using 3.25 mm needles and Cable method.

Row 1 *K1, k2tog, rep from * to end of row. [16]

Change to Yarn E.

Row 2 Purl.

Row 3 C&T.

Feet, make 2

Use Yarn C.

Cast on 4 sts using 4mm needles.

Row 1 * kfb, rep from * to end of row [8]

Row 2-6 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 5 rows.

Row 7 K1, *skp, YO, rep from * twice, skp, k1. [7]

Row 8-12 Beg with a P row, work in st st for 5 rows.

Row 13 K2tog, rep to last st, k1. [5]

Row 14 BO.

Cloak

Use Yarn B.

Cast on 57 sts using 4mm needles.

Row 1 *K1, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [85],

Row 2 K1, p1, k1, purl to last 3 sts, k1, p1, k1.

Row 3 K1, p1, Knit to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Row 4- 19 rep rows 2 & 3 eight times.

Row 20- 22 *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row.

Row 23 BO.

MAKING UP INSTRUCTIONS

Body and Head.

Starting at the base, use the BO yarn to gather the BO sts, next sew the back seam to the C&T yarn at the head.

Stuff the owl, taking care to keep the base flat.

Pull the C&T yarn to close the head and secure with small stitches.

Finished dimensions- 39cm /15" around middle- (measured around the start of stocking stitch head. Row 29)



Beak

Position the beak on the front of the owl opposite the back seam. Place the beak BO edge level with start of stocking stitch head. Row 29. Sew the BO edge only to the owl body.

Eyes make 2

Pull the C&T yarn to gather the middle of the pupil, secure with small stitches.



Use the CO yarn end to join the CO row ends together to create a circle.

Use Yarn D to embroider highlight onto each pupil.



Position the eyes on either side of the beak with the bottom edge level with start of stocking stitch head. Row 29.

Leave 1cm between the eyes. Use small stitches to sew each into position.

Feet

Fold each foot, wrong sides together in half along the picot row.

Oversew each edge of the foot.

Position the feet as shown, with the toes peeping out at the front of the owl.

Sew each foot into place.



Hat

Sew the back seam of the hat, use a small amount of stuffing to fill approx. one third of the hat from the tip down towards the crown.

Position the hat with the front just above the eyes, the back of the hat tilted towards the owl back.

Pin the hat in place and sew to the owl's head along the bottom of the Yarn C Hat Band.



Cloak

Sew the back seam. Weave in yarn ends.

Use Yarn C to embroider stars positioned randomly around the cloak.

Make the large stars 8 rows long and 6 rows wide. The small stars are 3 rows long and 2 rows high.





Wrap the cloak around the owl, sew the top front corners of the cloak together under the beak. Position the back higher than the front, so that the back is tucked under the hat.
