MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/6

1 skein of color 58
1 skein of color 03
1 skein of color 80
1 skein of color 98
1 skein of color 16
1 skein of color 51

Rainbow Cotton 8/6

Color 55 (leftover)
1 skein of color 08

Baby Cotton Organic Midi

1 skein of color 10

Crochet hook 2.75 mm / US C2
2 safety eyes 8 mm
Stuffing
Tapestry needle
Stitch marker

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/6**, Hobbii
100% Cotton
50 g / 1.75 oz = 105 m / 115 yds

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/6**, Hobbii
100% Cotton
50 g / 1.75 oz = 105 m / 114 yds

 **Baby Cotton Organic Midi**, Hobbii
100% Organic Egyptian Cotton
50 g / 1.75 oz = 105 m / 114 yds

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: Approx. 19 cm / 7.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Atahualpa Owl is an intermediate project, worked in a continuous spiral. To keep track of the rounds you may use a stitch marker or safety pin to mark the beginning of a round.

The head and the body are worked in a single piece. Atahualpa also has 2 accessories: a beret and a scarf.

Remember that it's always advisable to give the entire pattern a read before starting crocheting and, most importantly, be patient with yourself!

ABBREVIATIONS

mr = magic ring
 st = stitch
 Rnd = round
 Slst = slip stitch
 BLO = back loop only
 FLO = front loop only
 ch = chain
 sc = single crochet
 hdc = half double crochet
 dec = decrease (2 sts together)
 inc = increase (2 sts in the same st)

INFO AND TIPS

Head and body are worked in one piece. The color changes are worked in Jacquard technique, leaving the yarn we don't use behind the work when crocheting the diagram for the body, or cutting the strands when the color changes are widely spread, like in the owl's face.

CHEEKS (make 2)

Work with color (55)
 Rnd 1: 8 sc in mr [8]
 Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

BEAK

With color (08)
 Rnd 1: 5 sc in mr [5]
 Rnd 2: inc in all 5 st [10]
 Rnd 3: sc in all 10 st [10]
 Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Do not stuff.

HEAD AND BODY

Start with color (58)
 Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)
 Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) 6 times [18]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 6 times [24]

Rnd 5: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) 6 times [30]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) 6 times [36]

Rnd 7: (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st) 6 times [42]

Rnd 8: (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st) 6 times [48]

Rnd 9: (sc in next 7 st, inc in next st) 6 times [54]

Rnd 10: sc in all 54 st [54]

Continue working with alternating yarns (color 58 and color 03). The color you work with is indicated before each part.

Rnd 11: (*color 58*) sc in next 19 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 5 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 6 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 5 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 19 st [54]

Rnd 12: (*color 58*) sc in next 18 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 7 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 4 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 7 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 18 st [54]

Rnd 13: (*color 58*) sc in next 17 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 9 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 2 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 9 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 17 st [54]

Rnd 14-18: (*color 58*) sc in next 16 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 22 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 16 st [54]

Rnd 19: (*color 58*) sc in next 17 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 20 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 17 st [54]

Rnd 20: (*color 58*) sc in next 18 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 18 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 18 st [54]

Rnd 21: (*color 58*) sc in next 19 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 16 st, (*color 58*) sc in next 19 st [54]

Sew the beak between rounds 15 and 20. Insert the safety eyes between rounds 16 and 17, about 3 stitches away from the beak. Sew the cheeks below the safety eyes.

Change to color (80) and continue working in a jacquard pattern, alternating color (80), color (10) and color (03) according to the diagram.

Rnd 22-34: sc in all 54 st [54]

Change to color (58)

Rnd 35: BLO sc in all 54 st [54]

Rnd 36: (sc in next 7 st, dec) 6 times [48]

Rnd 37: sc in all 48 st [48]

Rnd 38: (sc in next 6 st, dec) 6 times [42]

Stuff the head.

Do not cut the yarn.

The legs

To make the legs, divide the work identifying 21 stitches for each leg. Find the middle back stitch. If you are not there yet, continue crocheting until that point or undo some stitches if needed. Ch 3 and join the last chain stitch to the 21th stitch of the previous round, working a single crochet stitch (this sc will be the first stitch of the leg). Now the stitches of the first leg are joined in the round. Continue working the first leg:

Rnd 1: sc in next 21 st on the body, BLO sc in next 3 ch [24]

Rnd 2: (sc in next 2 st, dec) 6 times [18]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, dec) 6 times [12]

Change to color (08).

Rnd 4: BLO (sc in next st, dec) 4 times [8]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the body and the leg firmly.

Second leg

Rejoin the color (58) yarn in the first unworked stitch at the back of round 38. This is where we start the first stitch of the second leg.

Rnd 1: sc in next 21 on the body, FLO sc in next 3 ch, sc in first st to join the round [24]

Rnd 2-4: repeat the pattern for the first leg.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the leg firmly.

Feet (make 2)

Work with color (08). Start with the toes, make 3.

Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

Rnd 2-3: sc in all 6 st [6]

Fasten off the first and second toe, leaving a tail for sewing. Don't fasten off the third toe. We will be joining the toes to make the foot.

Rnd 4: sc in next 3 st on the second toe, sc in all 6 st on the first toe, sc in leftover 3 st on the second toe, sc in all 6 st on the third toe [18]

You can close the holes between the toes using your tapestry needle and the leftover yarn tails. Stuff them lightly.

Rnd 5: sc in all 18 st [18]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 4 st, dec) 3 times [15]

Rnd 7: (sc in next 3 st, dec) 3 times [12]

Rnd 8: (sc in next 2 st, dec) 3 times [9]

Rnd 9: (sc in next st, dec) 3 times [6]

Rnd 10: sc in all 6 st [6]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.

Sew the feet to the legs.

EARS (make 2)

Work with color (58)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr [6]

Rnd 2: sc in all 6 st [6]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) 3 times [9]

Rnd 4-8: sc in all 9 st [9]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Do not stuff. Flatten and sew the ears to the head, between rounds 9 and 10.

WINGS (make 2)

Work with color (58)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr [6]

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) 3 times [15]

Rnd 5: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) 3 times [18]

Rnd 7: sc in all 18 st [18]

Rnd 8: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 6 times [24]

Rnd 9-14: sc in all 24 st [24]

Rnd 15: (sc in next 2 st, dec) 6 times [18]

Rnd 16-18: sc in all 18 st [18]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. The wings do not need to be stuffed. Flatten and sew the wings on both sides between rounds 20 and 21.

BERET

Start with color (98).

Rnd 1: start 9 hdc in a magic ring, slst in first st, ch 1 [9]

Rnd 2: hdc inc in all 9 st [18]

Rnd 3: (hdc in next st, hdc inc in next st) 9 times [27]

Rnd 4: (hdc in next 2 st, hdc inc in next st) 9 times [36]

Rnd 5: (hdc in next 3 st, hdc inc in next st) 9 times [45]

Rnd 6: (hdc in next 4 st, hdc inc in next st) 2 times, ch 4, skip 4, hdc inc in next st (hdc in next 4 st, hdc inc in next st) 3 times, ch 4, skip 4, hdc inc in next st (hdc in next 4 st, hdc inc in next st) 2 times [54]

Rnd 7: (hdc in next 2 st, hdc inc in next st) 18 times [72]

Rnd 8: hdc in all 72 st [72]

Rnd 9: (hdc in next 2 st, hdc dec) 18 times [54]

Change to color (10)

Rnd 10-11: sc in all 54 st [54]

Rnd 12: slst in al 54 st [54]

Fasten off and weave in the yarn ends.

Pompom

Start with color (16)

Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

Continue in a stripe pattern, changing color every round, alternating color (16) and color (51) yarn.

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) 6 times [18]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 6 times [24]

Rnd 5-8: sc in all 24 st [24]

Rnd 9: (sc in next 2 st, dec) 6 times [18]

Rnd 10: (sc in next st, dec) 6 times [12]

Stuff the pompom with fiberfill.

Rnd 11: dec 6 times [6]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew the pompom to the top of the beret.

SCARF

Work with color (16)

Ch 102. Crochet in rows


Row 1: start in third ch from the hook, hdc in next 100 st, ch 2, turn [100]

Row 2: BLO hdc in all 100 st, ch 2, turn [100]

Row 3: BLO hdc in all 100 st [100]

Fasten off and weave in the yarn ends.
