MATERIALS


Friends Wool

2 (2-3-3-4-4) skeins of Color 02, White
3 (4) 4 (5) 6 (6) skeins of Color 105, Emerald
7 (7) 8 (9) 9 (10) skeins of Color 40, Tomato
1 (1-1-1-1-1) skein of Color 28, Mustard

Circular needle 3.5 mm, 40 cm/US 7, 16"
Circular needle 4.5 mm, 80 cm/US 8, 31.5"

Stitch marker
Tapestry needle
Stitch wire

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii
100% Wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE

18 sts x 25 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm/ 4" x 4"

SIZE

1 (2-3-4-5-6)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 49.50 (52.50-57-64-70-74.50) cm
/ 19.5 (20.75-22.5-25.25-27.75-29.5)"
Length: 68 (70-72-74-76-78)
/ 26.75 (27.5-28.25-29.25-30-30.75)"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This merry sweater is worked top down in the round. Pattern on the yoke is worked after a chart. The sleeves and body are separated and worked in the round.

The sweater is available in a women's and children's version as well.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO: Bind off

BOR: Beginning of round

CO: Cast on

Dec: decrease

k: Knit

k tbl: Knit through the back loop

K2tog: Knit two together (decrease)

M1: Make-one. The most basic way to increase is knitting in the front and the back of a stitch.

p: Purl

Rnd / Rnds: Round, rounds

RS: Right side

SSK: Slip, slip, knit (decrease) – slip stitch knitwise, slip stitch knitwise, knit the 2 sts just slipped through back loops

St / Sts: Stitch, stitches

Yo: Yarn over

NECKLINE

CO 90 (90-96-96-102-110) sts with short circular needle size 3.5 mm in color 105.

Place BOR marker and join to work in the round. The round starts in the transition between the left shoulder and the back piece.

Rnd 1: k all sts

Rnd 2: *k1Tbl, p1* all sts

Repeat Rnd 2 additional 12 times

Switch to needle 4.5 mm

Rnd 15: K all stitches

Switch to color 40

Size 1

Rnds 16-18: k all sts (90 sts)

Size 2

Rnd 16: K 1 rnd where you increase 6 sts evenly spaced (96 sts)

Rnds 17-18: k all sts

Size 3

Rnd 16: K 1 rnd where you increase 6 sts evenly spaced (102 sts)

Rnds 17-19: k all sts

Size 4

Rnd 16: K 1 rnd where you increase 18 sts evenly spaced (114 sts)

Rnds 17-19: k all sts

Size 5

Rnd 16: K 1 rnd where you increase 24 sts evenly spaced (126 sts)

Rnds 17-20: k all sts

Size 6

Rnd 16: K 1 rnd where you increase 22 sts evenly spaced (132 sts)

Rnds 17-20: k all sts

All sizes

Rnd 19 (19-20-20-21-21): *K6, M1* repeat *-* till end of round = 105 (112-119-133-147-154) sts

Size 1-2

Rnds 20-21: k all sts

Size 3-4

Rnds 21-23: k all sts

Size 5-6

Rnds 22-25: k all sts

All sizes

Rnd 22 (22-24-24-26-26): *K7, M1* repeat *-* till end of round = 120 (128-136-152-168-176) sts

Size 1-2

Rnds 23-24: k all sts

Size 3-4

Rnds 25-27: k all sts

Size 5-6

Rnds 27-30: k all sts

All sizes

Rnd 25 (28-31): *K8, M1* repeat *-* till end of round = 135 (144-153-171-189-198) sts

Size 1-2

Rnds 26-27: k all sts

Size 3-4

Rnds 29-31: k all sts

Size 5-6

Rnds 32-35: k all sts

All sizes

Rnd 28 (32-36): *K9, M1* repeat *-* till end of round = 150 (160-170-190-210-220) sts

Rnd 29 (33-37): k all sts

Work **the chart** in your size a total of 15 (16-17-19-21-22) repeats. Changing to a longer cable when necessary. When the chart is completed there are 255 (272-289-323-357-374) sts on the needle.

Switch to color 40

Size 1-2

Rnd 65: k all sts

Rnd 66: *K17, M1* repeat *-* till end of round = 270-288 sts

Size 3

Rnd 69: k all sts

Rnd 70: *K17, M1* repeat *-* till end of round = 306 sts

Size 4

Rnd 73: k all sts

Rnd 74: *K17, M1* repeat *-* till end of round = 342 sts

Size 5-6

Rnds 77- 78: k all sts

Rnd 79: *K17, M1* repeat *-* till end of round = 378-396 sts

The piece should measure: 26.5 (26.5-28-29.5-30.5-30.5) cm/ 10.5 (10.5-11-11.5-12-12.5)''

Now divide for the body and sleeves as follows:

Remove BOR marker

k 89 (96-101-113-125-132) back sts. Slip 46 (48-52-58-64-66) sleeve sts to a stitch wire. CO 8 (8-10-12-14-16) underarm sts with backward loop CO.

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= 194 (208-222-250-278-296) sts on the needle

BODY (front+back)

k44 (48-50-56-62-66) sts and place BOR marker.

knit all sts

All sizes

Knit in the round until the body measures 42 (44.5-45-45-45-47) cm/ 16 (17.5-17.75-17.75-17.75-18.5)" from the underarm CO edge, or 6 cm/2.25" less than desired body length.

RIBBING

Switch to needle 4.5 mm.
Switch to color 105
Knit *k1 tbl, p1* ribbing for 6 cm/2.25".
BO loosely knitwise

SLEEVES

Make 2

Transfer 46 (48-52-58-64-66) sleeve sts from stitch wire to spare needle.

With RS facing, pick up 4 (4-5-6-7-8) sts from CO edge, place BOR marker, pick up 4 (4-5-6-7-8) more sts from CO edge
= 54 (56-62-70-78-82) sts on the needle

Now work the sleeve in the round alternating 8 rounds of red and 8 rounds of white.
The first stripe should take into account the number of red rounds made in the yoke to arrive at a minimum of 8 red rounds.

At the same time decrease two stitches every 8 (8-5-3-3-2.5) cm / 3.25 (3.25-2-1.25-1.25-1) as follows:

k1, k2tog, knit until 3 st before underarm sts, ssk, k to BOR.

Repeat dec rnd additional 4 (4-6-9-12-13) times = 46 (48-50-52-54-56) sts on the needle

Knit until sleeve measures 32 (32-32-33-33-33) cm/ 12.5 (12.5-12.5-13-13-13) from underarm CO edge, or 8 cm/3.25" less than desired sleeve length.

Switch to color 105

Knit 1 rnd

RIBBING

Switch to needle 3.5 mm.
Knit *k1 tbl, p1* ribbing for 8 cm/3.25".
BO loosely knitwise

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wet block
