## Sweater

## MATERIALS


### Friends Wool

2 (2-3-3-4-4) skeins of Color 02, White  
3 (4-4-5-6-6) skeins of Color 105, Emerald  
6 (6-7-8-8-9) skeins of Color 40, Tomato  
1 (1-1-1-1-1) skein of Color 28, Mustard

Circular needle 3.5 mm, 40 cm/US 7, 16"  
Circular needle 4.5 mm, 80 cm/US 8, 31.5"

Stitch marker  
Tapestry needle  
Stitch wire

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii  
100% Wool  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

## GAUGE

18 sts x 25 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm/ 4" x 4"

## SIZE

1 (2-3-4-5-6)

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 45 (49-52-57-64-70) cm / 18  
(19.50-20.75-22.5-25.25-27.75)"  
Length: 50 (55-58-60-62-64) cm / 19.75  
(21.75-22.75-23.5-24.5-25.25)"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This merry sweater is worked top down in the round. Pattern on the yoke is worked after a chart. The sleeves and body are separated and worked in the round.

This sweater is available in a men's and children's version as well.

# Pattern



## ABBREVIATIONS

BO: Bind off

BOR: Beginning of round

CO: Cast on

k: Knit

k tbl: Knit through the back loop

M1: Make-one. The most basic way to increase is knitting in the front and the back of a stitch.

p: Purl

Rnd / Rnds: Round, rounds

RS: Right side

St / Sts: Stitch, stitches

Yo: Yarn over

## NECKLINE

CO 76 (80-84-88-96-104) sts with short circular needle size 3.5 mm in color 105.

Place BOR marker and join to work in the round. The round starts in the transition between the left shoulder and the back piece.

Rnd 1: k all sts

Rnd 2: \*k1Tbl, p1\* to the end of the round

Repeat Rnd 2 additional 7 times

Switch to needle 4.5 mm

Rnd 10: K all stitches

Switch to color 40

### Size 1

Rnd 11: K1 rnd where you increase 8 sts evenly spaced (84 sts)

Rnd 12: k all sts

### Size 2

Rnd 11: K 1 rnd where you increase 10 sts evenly spaced (90 sts)

Rnd 12: k all sts

**Size 3**

Rnd 11: K1 rnd where you increase 12 sts evenly spaced (96 sts)

Rnds 12-13: k all sts

**Size 4**

Rnd 11: K1 rnd where you increase 14 sts evenly spaced (102 sts)

Rnds 12 - 13: k all sts

**Size 5**

Rnd 11: K 1 rnd where you increase 18 sts evenly spaced (114 sts)

Rnds 12- 14: k all sts

**Size 6**

Rnd 11: K 1 rnd n where you increase 22 sts evenly spaced (126 sts)

Rnds 12 -14: k all sts

**All sizes:**

Rnd 13 (14-15): \*K6, M1\* repeat \*-\* till end of round = 98 (105-112-119-133-147) sts

**Size 1-2**

Rnds 14-15: K all sts

**Size 3-4**

Rnds 15-17: K all sts

**Size 5-6**

Rnds 16-19: K all sts

**All sizes:**

Rnd 16 (18-20): \*K7, M1\* repeat \*-\* till end of round = 112 (120-128-136-152-168) sts

**Size 1-2**

Rnds 17-18: K all sts

**Size 3-4**

Rnds 19-20: K all sts

**Size 5-6**

Rnds 21-22: K all sts

**All sizes:**

Rnd 19 (22-25): \*K8, M1\* repeat \*-\* till end of round =126 (135-144-153-171-189) sts

**Size 1-2**

Rnds 20-21: K all sts

**Size 3-4**

Rnds 22-23: K all sts

**Size 5-6**

Rnds 24-25: K all sts

**All sizes:**

Rnd 22 (26-30): \*K9, M1\* repeat \*-\* till end of round = 140 (150-160-170-190-210) sts

Rnd 23 (27-31): K all sts

Work **the chart** in your size in the rnd a total of 14 (15-16-17-19-21) repeats. Changing to longer cables when necessary.

When the chart is completed there are 238 (255-272-289-323-357) sts on the needle.

Switch to color 40

**Size 1-2**

Rnd 52: K all sts

Rnd 53: \*K17, M1\* repeat \*-\* till end of round = 252-270 sts

**Size 3**

Rnd 56: K all sts

Rnd 57: \*K17, M1\* repeat \*-\* till end of round = 288 sts

**Size 4**

Rnd 58: K all sts

Rnd 59: \*K17, M1\* repeat \*-\* till end of round = 306 sts

**Size 5**

Rnd 62- 64: K all sts = 342 sts

**Size 6**

Rnd 62- 63: K all sts

Rnd 64: \*K17, M1\* repeat \*-\* till end of round = 378 sts

The piece should measure: 20.5 (20.5-22-22.75-24.5-24.5) cm/ 8 (8-8.75-9-9.5-9.5)"

Now divide for the body and sleeves as follows:

Remove BOR marker

K 84 (91-96-103-115-125) back sts. Slip 42 (44-48-50-56-64) sleeve sts to a stitch wire. CO 4 (6-6-8-10-12) underarm sts with backward loop CO.

K 84 (91-96-103-115-125) front sts. Slip 42 (44-48-50-56-64) sleeve sts to a stitch wire. CO 4 (6-6-8-10-12) underarm sts with backward loop CO.

= 176 (194-204-222-250-274) sts on the needle

**BODY (front+back)**

k42 (34-45-48-51-27-62) sts and place BOR marker.

**All sizes**

Knit until the body measures 29 (34-36-37-37-39) cm/ 11.75 (13.5-14.25-14.5-14.75-15.5)" from the underarm CO edge, or 6 cm/2.25" less than desired body length.

## RIBBING

Switch to needle 4.5 mm.  
Switch to color 105  
Knit \*k1 tbl, p1\* ribbing for 6 cm/2.25".  
BO loosely knitwise

## SLEEVES

Transfer 42 (44-48-50-56-64) sleeve sts from stitch wire to spare needle.  
With RS facing, pick up 2 (3-3-4-5-6) sts from CO edge, place BOR marker, pick up 2 (3-3-4-5-6) more sts from CO edge. Knit sleeve sts to BOR.

= 46 (50-54-58-66-76) sts on the needle

Work the sleeve in the round alternating 8 rounds of red and 8 rounds of white.  
The first stripe should take into account the number of red rounds made in the yoke to arrive at a minimum of 8 red rounds.

Knit until sleeve measures 36 (36-38-38-40-40) cm from underarm CO edge, or 8 cm/3.25" less than desired sleeve length.

Switch to color 105

Dec rnd: Knit 1 rnd where you decrease 16 (16-20-18-18-28) sts evenly spaced  
= 30 (34-34-40-48-48) sts on the needle

## RIBBING







Switch to needle 3.5 mm.  
Knit \*k1 tbl, p1\* ribbing for 8 cm/3.25".  
BO loosely knitwise

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wet block
