Lucia

Children's Sweater

MATERIALS

UNI-COLORED – ALTERNATIVE 1

2 (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) skeins of Divina, color Sangria (15)

2 (3) 3 (3) 3 (3) skeins of Friends Kid Silk, color Maroon (49)

UNI-COLORED – ALTERNATIVE 2

2 (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) skeins of Divina, color Sangria (15)

1 (2) 2 (2) 2 (2) skein(s) of Soft Alpaca Lace, color Deep Red (10)

Circular needle 5.5 mm (US 9) – 40 cm (16") and 80 cm (32") The needle size is a suggestion. If you do not get the right gauge, change to a smaller or larger needle size and try again.

YARN QUALITY

 **Divina**, Hobbii

65 % Alpaca, 28 % Polyamide, 7 % Wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 150 m (164 yds)

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii

72 % Mohair, 25 % Silk, 3 % Wool
25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 m (218 yds)

 **Soft Alpaca Lace**, Hobbii

100 % Alpaca
50 g (1.75 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

GAUGE

15 sts x 26 rows = 10 cm (4")

SIZE

2 (3-4) 5-6 (7-8) 9-10 (11-12) years

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 33 (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) cm / 13 (14.25) 15.75 (17.25) 19 (20.5)"

Width: 31.5 (33.5) 35.5 (38) 40 (42.5) cm / 12.5 (13.25) 14 (15) 15.75 (16.75)"

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The Lucia Sweater is worked top down. The neckline and the yoke are worked in the round on a circular needle with a delicate lace pattern. The yoke is divided into sleeves, back piece and front piece and worked in stockinette stitch. Lastly, the sleeves are worked.

The pattern includes lace pattern charts with instructions.

The sweater is worked with one strand of each yarn held together.

TWO-COLORED – ALTERNATIVE 1

Main color

2 (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) skeins of Divina
 1 (2) 2 (2) 2 (2) skein(s) of Soft Alpaca Lace

Contrasting color

1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein of Divina
 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein of Soft Alpaca Lace

TWO-COLORED – ALTERNATIVE 2

Main color

2 (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) skeins of Divina
 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 (3) skeins of Friends Kid Silk

Contrasting color

1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein of Divina
 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein of Friends Kid Silk

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)
 k = knit
 p = purl
 tbl = through the back loop
 rnd(s) = round(s)
 RS = right side
 WS = wrong side
 yo = yarn over
 sl1k = slip 1 stitch knitwise
 k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
 p3tog = purl 3 stitches together
 co = cast on
 bo = bind off
 pssso = pass slipped stitch over
 BOR = beginning of round

INFORMATION AND TIPS

SIZE GUIDE

The measurements stated in the pattern only apply if you get the right gauge.

2 (3/4) 5/6 (7/8) 9/10 (11/12) years.

The size corresponds to the child's height: 92 (98/104) 110/116 (122/128) 134/140 (146/152) cm / 36.25 (38.5/41) 43.25/45.75 (48/50.5) 52.75/55 (57.5/59.75)".

TIPS FOR DECREASING (sleeves)

1 st is increased on each side of the marker like this: K until 2 sts before marker, sl1k, k1, pssso, slip marker, k2tog.

TIPS FOR INCREASING (yoke)

Pick up the bar between 2 sts and k tbl.

NECKLINE AND YOKE

With one strand of each yarn held together and using circular needle 5.5 mm (US 9), co 54 (56) 58 (60) 62 (64) sts. Work rib stitch like this: *k1tbl, p1; repeat from * to end. Work until the ribbing measures 2.5 cm / 1". K 1 rnd while increasing 12 (13) 13 (15) 17 (19) sts evenly across = 66 (69) 71 (75) 79 (83) sts. K 3 rnds (2 rnds if you work with 2 colors). Then k 1 rnd while increasing 12 (15) 13 (15) 17 (19) sts evenly across = 78 (84) 84 (90) 96 (102) sts. Follow chart A if your sweater is uni-colored. Follow chart B if your sweater is two-colored. The pattern repeat is worked a total of 13 (14) 14 (15) 16 (17) times on the rnd. This constitutes the first pattern band on the yoke. K 3 rnds. On the next rnd, increase 24 (24) 30 (30) 30 (36) sts evenly across. Follow chart A. Follow chart B if your sweater is two-colored. The pattern repeat is worked a total of 17 (18) 19 (20) 21 (23) times on the rnd. This constitutes the second pattern band on the yoke.

K 4 rnds. On the next rnd, increase 25 (27) 30 (34) 39 (40) sts evenly across. Work 2 cm / 0.75" in stockinette stitch. On the next rnd, increase 25 (27) 30 (34) 39 (42) sts evenly across = 152 (162) 174 (188) 204 (220) sts. Work until the work measures 15 (16) 17 (18) 19 (20) cm / 6 (6.25) 6.75 (7) 7.5 (8)".

BODY

Divide the work into body and sleeves like this: K 45 (48) 50 (54) 58 (64) sts (back piece), place 31 (33) 37 (40) 44 (46) sts on a stitch wire (sleeve) and co 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 (4) sts between front piece and back piece K 45 (48) 50 (54) 58 (64) sts (front piece), place 31 (33) 37 (40) 44 (46) sts on a stitch wire (sleeve) and co 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 (4) sts between front piece and back piece. The body now consists of 96 (102) 106 (116) 124 (136) sts.

Work stockinette stitch in the round until the work measures approx 30 (33) 37 (41) 45 (49) cm / 11.75 (13) 14.5 (16) 17.75 (19.25)" or until it reaches your desired length (try the sweater to check). K 1 rnd while increasing 6 (6) 6 (8) 8 (8) sts evenly across. Work 3 cm / 1.25" in rib stitch like this: *k1tbl, p1; repeat from * to end.

SLEEVE

Place the sts from the stitch wire on a circular needle and pick up 1 st in each of the 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 (4) new sts below the sleeve = 34 (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) sts. Place a marker in the middle of the picked up sts (BOR). Work stockinette stitch in the round. When the work measures 2 cm / 0.75" from the division, decrease 1 st on each side of the marker. Decrease like this every 2 (2) 2 (2.5) 2.5 (2.5) cm / 0.75 (0.75) 0.75 (1) 1 (1)" a total of 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 (4) times = 28 (30) 34 (36) 40 (42) sts. Work until the sleeve measures 19 (22) 26 (31) 34 (38) cm / 7.5 (8.75) 10.25 (12.25) 13.5 (15)" from the division or until it reaches your desired length (try the sweater to check). Work 2.5 cm / 1" in rib stitch like this: *k1tbl, p1; repeat from * to end. Bo loosely Work the second sleeve following the same procedure.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends.
