

OMG – HOODED SCARF

Vibrantly striped scarf with attached shaped hood



The infinite color combinations of this staple hooded scarf will make you say OMG! 5 colors are striped throughout this linen stitch accessory using a method that cuts way down on ends. The hood is added directly to the scarf and lightly shaped to avoid an unsightly point at the back. Finish up with a neat row for the border and you've got a 2-in-1 accessory that will keep the chill away in style.

The OMG Hooded Scarf pattern is part of the Happy Place pattern collection, designed to complement Happy Place Apricity Yarn. Find even more patterns and get the yarn needed for this project from Hobbii's website.

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PROJECT SUPPLIES

YARN: Hobbii Happy Place Apricity, super bulky weight (#6); 65% alpaca, 28% polyamide, 7% wool [76 yards per 50g skein].

Sample uses 2 skeins of Color 01 (A), and 1 skein each of Colors 09 (B), 11 (C), 18 (D), and 13 (E).

HOOK: US M/N (9mm) crochet hook, or size needed to achieve gauge.

NOTIONS: Scissors, tapestry needle, locking stitch marker, steam blocking supplies.

DIMENSIONS

FINISHED SIZE: Scarf measures 8" (20.25cm) wide x 66" (167.5cm) long; Hood measures 12" (30.5cm) long x 9.5" (24.25cm) deep when measured flat.

GAUGE: 6" (15.25cm) = 14 sts x 13 rows in (sc 1, ch 1) pattern; ch-1 counted as stitch in gauge measurement

ABBREVIATIONS

CC = change color

Ch = chain

Fsc = foundation single crochet ([tutorial](#))

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

Sc = single crochet

Sc2tog = single crochet 2 together

Sk = skip

Sl St(s) = slip stitch(es)

Sp = space

St(s) = stitch(es)

PATTERN DIRECTIONS

NOTES

-Starting ch-2 counts as sc + ch 1.

-COLOR CHANGES: Change color every row throughout pattern unless otherwise instructed. Keep yarn not in use attached to work; carry yarn up both sides of the work. Progress through colors A-E.

-WORKING IN PATTERN: When instructed to work in pattern, maintain the (ch 1, sc in next ch-sp) linen stitch pattern.

HOODED SCARF

SCARF

ROW 1: With A, fsc 160, cc to B, turn. Alternatively, ch 161, sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across row, cc to B, turn.

ROW 2: Ch 2, sk sc at base of ch, sc in next st, (ch 1, sk 1, sc in next st) across row, cc to C. (80 sc)

ROWS 3-18: Ch 2, sk sc at base of ch, sc in next ch-sp, (ch 1, sc in next ch-sp) across row, placing last sc in ch-2 sp, cc to next color in sequence, turn. Scarf will include 3 total repeats of the color sequence, then colors A-C.

Fasten off all colors after last row.

HOOD

ROW 1: With WS of Row 18 from Scarf facing, sk 26 sc, place marker in sp after last skipped st. Join D with a sl st in marked sp with D, sk next sc, sc in next ch-sp, (ch 1, sc in next ch-sp) 26 times, cc to E, turn. (26 sc)

ROWS 2-27: Ch 2, sk sc at base of ch, sc in next ch-sp, (ch 1, sc in next ch-sp) across, placing last sc in ch-2 sp, cc to next color in sequence, turn. Last row is completed in E, cc to A for next row.

SHAPING ROWS

ROW 1: Ch 2, sk sc at base of ch, sc in next ch-sp, (ch 1, sc in next sp) **11** times, ch 1, sk next sc, sc2tog over next 2 ch-sps, (ch 1, sc in next sp) across, placing last sc in ch-2 sp, cc to next color in sequence, turn.

ROW 2: Ch 2, sk sc at base of ch, sc in next ch-sp, (ch 1, sc in next ch-sp) across, placing last sc in ch-2 sp, cc to next color in sequence, turn.

ROWS 3-4: Repeat Rows 1-2, maintaining color change.

ROW 5: Ch 2, sk sc at base of ch, sc in next ch-sp, (ch 1, sc in next sp) **10** times, ch 1, sk next sc, sc2tog over next 2 ch-sps, (ch 1, sc in next sp) across, placing last sc in ch-2 sp, cc to next color in sequence, turn.

ROW 6: With A, ch 2, sk sc at base of ch, sc in next ch-sp, (ch 1, sc in next ch-sp) across, placing last sc in ch-2 sp.

Fasten off all colors, leaving a long tail of A for seaming the Hood.

Fold hood in half along Row 6. Whip stitch seam the stitches of Row 6 together using the remaining tail of A.

Weave in all remaining ends.

BORDER

With A and RS facing, join in the bottom corner of Scarf with a sl st and adjust to work along the short side of the scarf. **See reference photo on last page.** Complete the border in one continuous row, using the following steps –

STEP 1: With A, join where indicated with a slip stitch, ch 1, sc in same place as join, sc in each row end, working over the floats, ch 2 at corner and rotate to work along scarf toward Hood.

STEP 2: Work in pattern along row to Hood.

STEP 3: Sc in each row end of Hood, working over the floats across entire opening of the hood.

STEP 4: Work in pattern along row to corner, ch 2 at corner and rotate to work along next edge, sc in each row end, working over the floats. Fasten off.

You should now have a border of Color A around the entirety of the piece. We did not crochet along the bottom of the Scarf, as there is already a row of color A along the bottom.

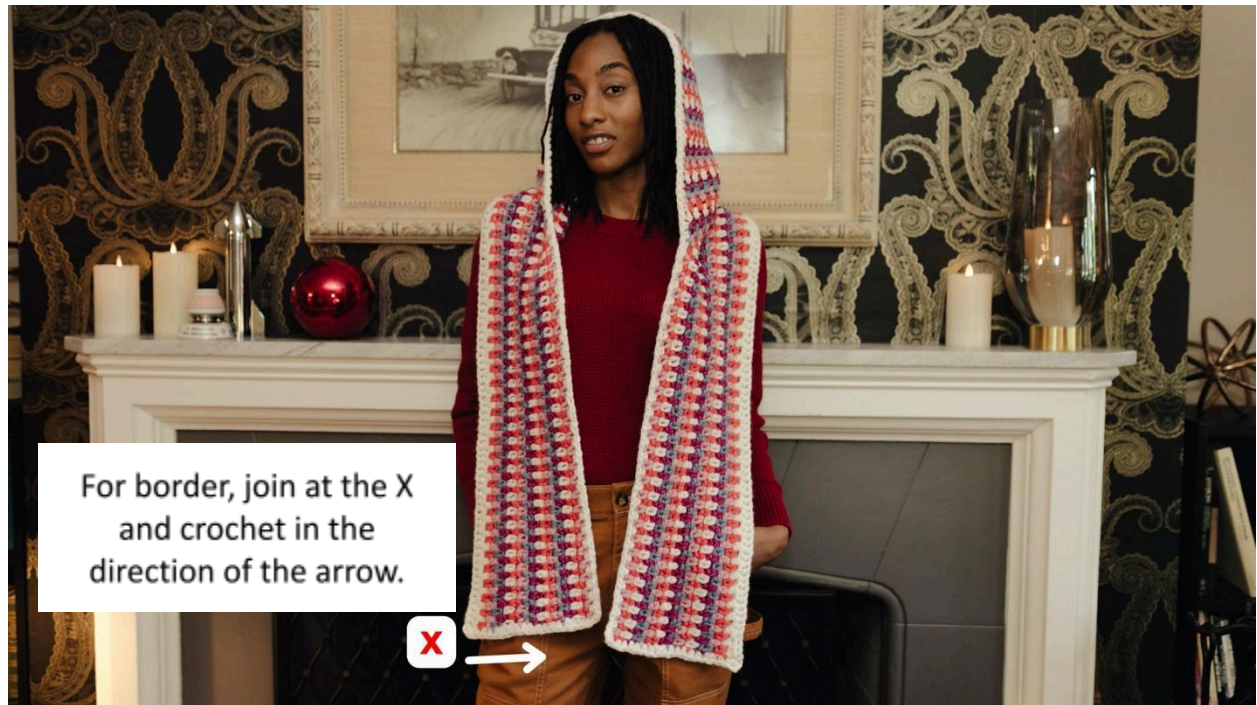
Weave in all ends.

Steam block to final dimensions.



JOINING FOR THE BORDER

Use this image as a reference for where to join to begin the Border.



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
