# Oak Seed

Textured Socks

## MATERIALS

**Hobbii** Unicorn Solid

**Shade:** Caramel (21); 1 skein

2.5 mm / US 2 circular needle, 100cm / 40" length for magic loop, or needles suitable for working small circumferences in the round

Always use a needle size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

3 stitch markers, cable needle, tapestry needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Unicorn Solid**, Hobbii

Fingering / 4-ply-weight

75% Wool, 25% Polyamide

100 g (3.5 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

## GAUGE

36 sts & 52 rounds = 10 cm / 4" over St st in the round, after blocking

## SIZE

1 (2)

## MEASUREMENTS

**Finished foot circumference:** 16.5 (20)cm / 6½ (8)" - to be worn with 1.5-2.5cm / ½-1" negative ease

Foot length is adjustable.

## PATTERN INFORMATION

The Oak Seed socks are knitted cuff-down in one piece, starting with a picot edge, then half-twisted rib stitch. The socks are decorated with lace on the top of the foot and texture over the leg. The heel is made with the heel flap and gusset method.

## Pattern



### ABBREVIATIONS

<b>Beg</b>	beginning
<b>CN</b>	cable needle
<b>Dec</b>	decrease
<b>K</b>	Knit
<b>K1tbl</b>	Knit through the back loop
<b>K2tog</b>	Knit 2 stitches together
<b>M1L</b>	make 1 left knit
<b>M1LP</b>	Make 1 left purl
<b>M1R</b>	Make 1 right knit
<b>M1RP</b>	Make 1 right purl
<b>P2tog</b>	Purl 2 stitches together
<b>PM</b>	Place marker
<b>RC</b>	Right cross
<b>Rep</b>	Repeat
<b>RS</b>	Right side
<b>Sl</b>	Slip
<b>SM</b>	Slip marker
<b>Ssk</b>	Slip 2 stitches knitwise one at a time, knit them together through back loop
<b>Sssk</b>	Slip 3 stitches knitwise one at a time, knit them together through back loop
<b>St(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>Wyib</b>	with yarn in back
<b>Wyif</b>	with yarn in front
<b>Yo</b>	yarn over

## STITCH GLOSSARY

**1/2 LC (sssk)** Sl 3 sts to CN and hold in front, k2, sssk from CN.

**1/2 RC (sssk)** Sl 3 sts to CN and hold in back, k2, sssk from CN.

**Kyok:** (k1, yo, k1) into 1 st.

### Picot Cast On

Step 1. Using the Knitted cast-on method, cast on 5 sts to left needle.

Step 2. K2, cast off 1 st, k1, cast off 1 st, slip last st to left needle.

Step 3. Using the Knitted cast-on method, cast on 4 stitches.

Rep Steps 2-3 for cast on, ending with Step 2.

## PATTERN BEGINS

### CUFF

Using needles suitable for working small circumferences in the round and the Picot Cast-on method, cast on 60 (72) sts. Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. PM to indicate beg of round.

**Rounds 1-10:** [P1, k1tbl] to end.

### LEG

**Next round:** Work round 1 of Chart A to end, working 12-st rep 5 (6) times across round.

Working next round of chart each time, continue as set until round 19 of Chart A is complete.

**Next round:** Remove beg of round marker, k4, PM for new beg of round, k to end.

Knit 4 rounds.

Work rounds 1-19 of Chart B.

Knit 4 rounds.

### HEEL

#### Heel flap

K29 (35) sts for instep and place on hold. Heel flap will be worked over the last 31 (37) sts of round.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl2 wyib, k1, [sl1, k1] 14 (17) times.

**Row 2 (WS):** Sl1 wyif, p to end.

**Row 3:** [Sl1 wyib, k1] to last 3 sts, sl1, k2.

**Row 4:** Rep row 2.

Rep rows 1-4 a further 6 (8) times.

**Size 1 ONLY:** Rep rows 1-2 once more.

## Heel Turn

**Row 1 (RS)(dec):** Sl1 wyib, k17 (20), ssk, k1, turn. *1 st dec*

**Row 2 (WS) (dec):** Sl1 wyif, p6, p2tog, p1, turn. *1 st dec*

**Row 3 (dec):** Sl1 wyib, knit to 1 st before gap, ssk, k1, turn. *1 st dec*

**Row 4 (dec):** Sl1 wyif, purl to 1 st before gap, p2tog, p1, turn. *1 st dec*

Rep rows 3-4 a further 4 (5) times. *19 (23) sts*

## Size 2 ONLY:

**Next row (dec):** Sl1 wyib, knit to 1 st before gap, ssk, turn. *22 sts*

**Next row (dec):** Sl1 wyif, purl to 1 st before gap, p2tog, turn. *21 sts*

## GUSSET

**Set-up round:** K19 (21) heel sts, pick up and knit 1 st from corner of heel, PM, pick up and knit 14 (17) sts from heel flap and 1 st between heel and instep, PM for instep, work round 1 of Chart C across 29 (35) instep sts, PM for instep, pick up and knit 1 st between instep and heel and 14 (17) sts from heel flap, PM, pick up and knit 1 st from corner of heel, k9 (10), PM for new beg of round. *80 (94) sts*

**Round 1 (dec):** K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, SM, k to marker, SM, work next round of Chart C, SM, k to marker, SM, ssk, k to end. *2 sts dec*

**Round 2:** [K to marker, SM] twice, work next round of Chart C, [SM, k to marker] twice. Working next round of chart each time, rep rounds 1-2 a further 8 (9) times. *62 (74) sts*

Remove all markers except beg of round.

**Next round:** Work in pattern to last st, sl1, remove marker, k2tog, pass slipped st over, PM for new beg of round. *60 (72) sts*

## FOOT

**Round 1:** Work in pattern to end, continuing to work Chart C over instep sts.

Work straight in patterns until foot measures 4cm / 1½" less than desired total foot length.

## TOE

**Set-up round:** K30 (36), PM, k to end.

**Round 1 (dec):** [K1, ssk, k to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1] twice, ending at beg of round marker. *4 sts dec*

**Round 2:** K to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 a further 7 (9) times. *28 (32) sts*

Divide sts over 2 needles and graft toe closed.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block.

## SCHEMATIC

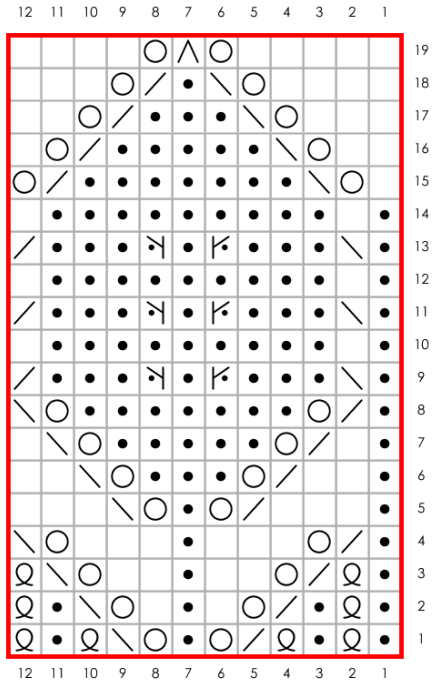


**A. Finished foot circumference:** 16.5 cm/6½", (20 cm/8")

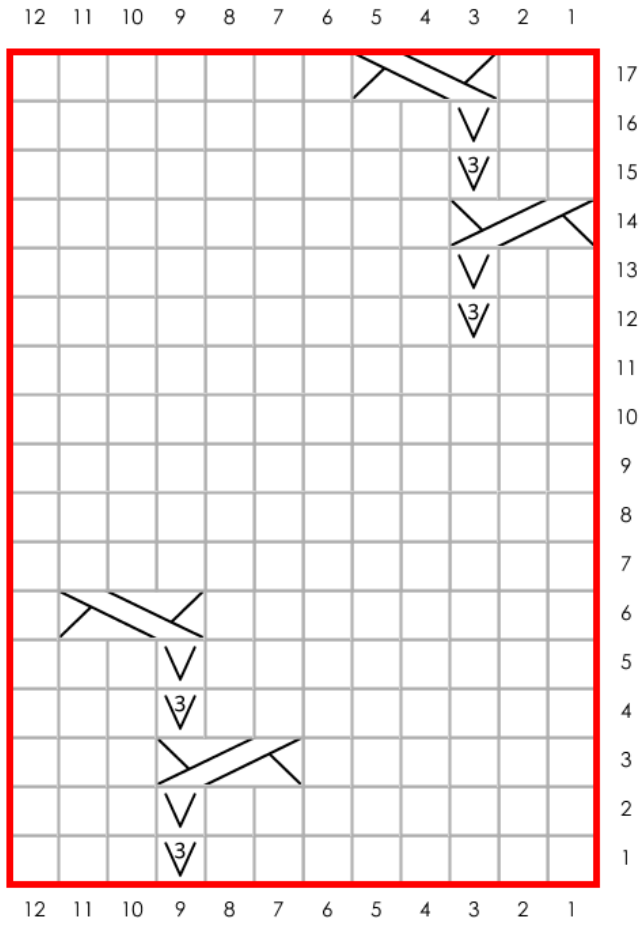

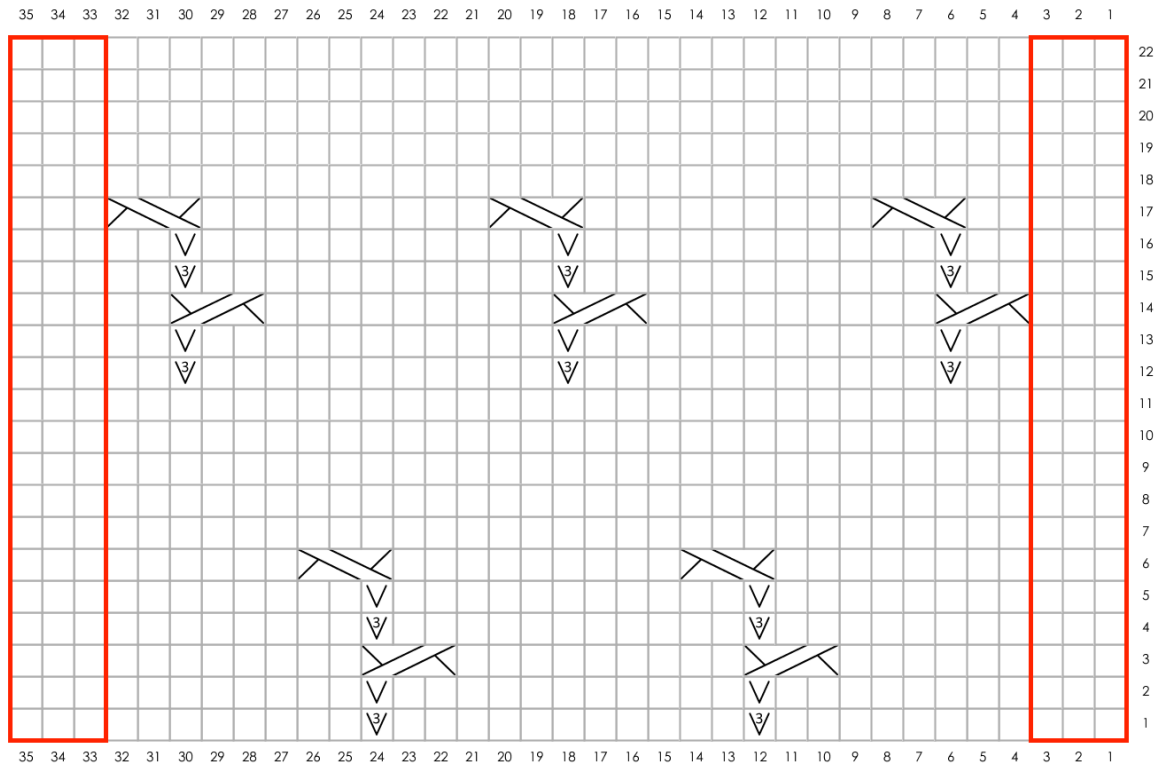

## WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHARTS

### CHART A

**Round 1:** [P1, k1tbl] twice, k2tog, yo, p1, yo, ssk, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl.

**Round 2:** P1, k1tbl, p1, k2tog, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, ssk, p1, k1tbl.

**Round 3:** P1, k1tbl, k2tog, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, ssk, k1tbl.

**Round 4:** P1, k2tog, yo, k3, p1, k3, yo, ssk.

**Round 5:** P1, k3, k2tog, yo, p1, yo, ssk, k3.

**Round 6:** P1, k2, k2tog, yo, p3, yo, ssk, k2.

**Round 7:** P1, k1, k2tog, yo, p5, yo, ssk, k1.

**Round 8:** P1, k2tog, yo, p7, yo, ssk.

**Round 9:** P1, ssk, p3, M1RP, p1, M1PL, p3, k2tog.

**Round 10:** P1, k1, p9, k1.

**Rounds 11-14:** Rep rounds 9-10 twice.

**Round 15:** K1, yo, ssk, p7, k2tog, yo.

**Round 16:** K2, yo, ssk, p5, k2tog, yo, k1.

**Round 17:** K3, yo, ssk, p3, k2tog, yo, k2.

**Round 18:** K4, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, k3.

**Round 19:** K5, yo, sl1, k2tog, pass slipped st over, yo, k4.

### CHART B

**Round 1:** K8, kyok, k3.

**Round 2:** K8, sl3, k3.

**Round 3:** K6, 1/2 RC, k3.

**Round 4:** K8, kyok, k3.

**Round 5:** K8, sl3, k3.

**Round 6:** K8, 1/2 LC, k1.

**Rounds 7-11:** K to end.

**Round 12:** K2, kyok, k9.

**Round 13:** K2, sl3, k9.

**Round 14:** 1/2 RC, k9.

**Round 15:** K2, kyok, k9.

**Round 16:** K2, sl3, k9.

**Round 17:** K2, 1/2 LC, k7.

### CHART C – SIZE 1 ONLY

**Round 1:** K8, kyok, k11, kyok, k8.

**Round 2:** K8, sl3, k11, sl3, k8.

**Round 3:** K6, 1/2 RC, k9, 1/2 RC, k8.

**Round 4:** K8, kyok, k11, kyok, k8.

**Round 5:** K8, sl3, k11, sl3, k8.

**Round 6:** K8, 1/2 LC, k9, 1/2 LC, k6.

**Rounds 7-11:** K to end.

**Round 12:** K2, [kyok, k11] twice, kyok, k2.

**Round 13:** K2, [sl3, k11] twice, sl3, k2.

**Round 14:** [1/2 RC, k9] twice, 1/2 RC, k2.

**Round 15:** K2, [kyok, k11] twice, kyok, k2.

**Round 16:** K2, [sl3, k11] twice, sl3, k2.

**Round 17:** K2, [1/2 LC, k9] twice, 1/2 LC.

**Rounds 18-22:** K to end.

## CHART C – SIZE 2 ONLY

**Round 1:** K11, kyok, k11, kyok, k11.

**Round 2:** K11, sl3, k11, sl3, k11.

**Round 3:** K9, 1/2 RC, k9, 1/2 RC, k11.

**Round 4:** K11, kyok, k11, kyok, k11.

**Round 5:** [K11, sl3] twice, k11.

**Round 6:** K11, 1/2 LC, k9, 1/2 LC, k9.

**Rounds 7-11:** K to end.

**Round 12:** K5, [kyok, k11] twice, kyok, k5.

**Round 13:** K5, [sl3, k11] twice, sl3, k5.

**Round 14:** K3, [1/2 RC, k9] twice, 1/2 RC, k5.

**Round 15:** K5, [kyok, k11] twice, kyok, k5.

**Round 16:** K5, [sl3, k11] twice, sl3, k5.

**Round 17:** K5, [1/2 LC, k9] twice, 1/2 LC, k3.

**Rounds 18-22:** K to end.
