MATERIALS

2 skeins of Panettone color 10

Crochet hook 3.5 mm / US E/4

Yarn needle

Scissors

YARN QUALITY

 **Panettone**, Hobbii

87 % Cotton, 7 % Polyamide, 6 % Metallic
Fiber

50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

GAUGE

17 sts x 21 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

ls = loop stitch

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 16 cm / 6.25"

Length: 17 cm / 6.75"

The Diana Bag is a super fun and trendy crochet handbag pattern made with cool loop stitches! It's colorful with shiny metallic accents, making it perfect for special occasions like a night out or a fancy party. The bag has lots of texture, so it really stands out and looks stylish.

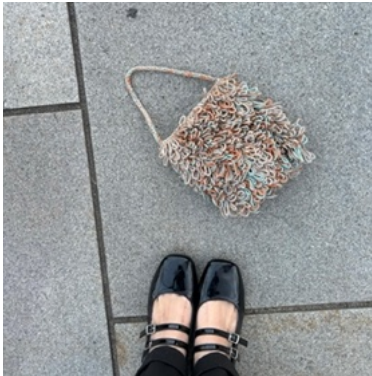

INFO AND TIPS

Here's how to crochet a Loop Stitch (ls):

First make a slip knot and chain any number of stitches. Once you've completed your foundation chain, start with a row of single crochet stitches. This will serve as a base for the loop stitches.

Start from the second chain from the hook and single crochet all.

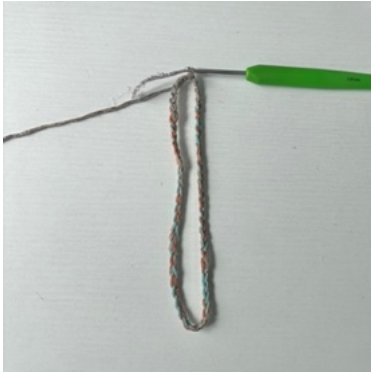
Ch 1 and turn. Now that you have the base row, we can start the loop stitch:

Insert your hook into the next stitch, wrap the yarn around your finger to form a loop (try to keep all loops about the same size), yarn over and pull through the stitch, then drop the large loop. Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull through all the loops.

BODY

Ch 64. Make sure your foundation chain is not twisted and join both ends with a sl st.



Now crochet in rounds.

R1: Ch 1, sc 64, sl st to join the round. (64)

R2: Ch 1, ls 64, sl st to join the round. (64)



R3 - R36: repeat R1 and R2.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

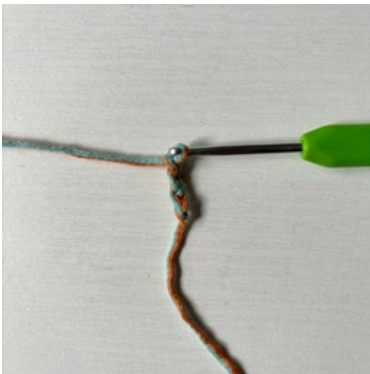


Flip your project inside out and close the bottom of the bag with 32 sl sts. Weave in the ends.

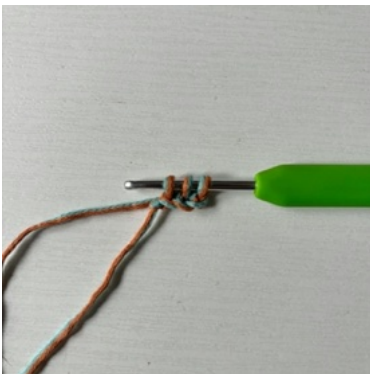


I-CORD STRAP

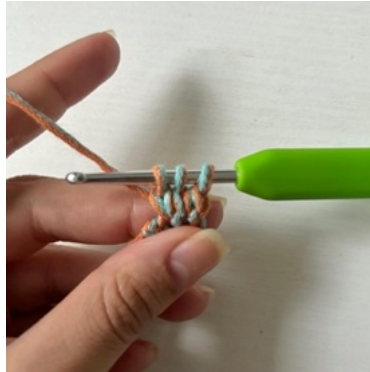
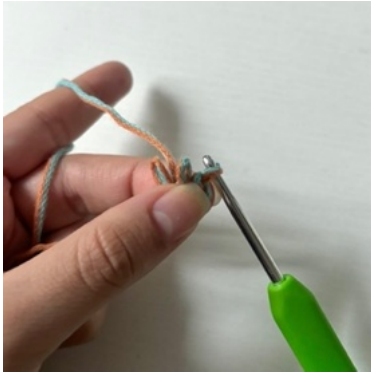
Make a slip knot and ch 3.



R1: Ch 1 into the 2nd ch from the hook, ch 1 into the last ch.



R2: drop 2 loops off the hook and hold them. Ch 1, then ch 1 in the next loop and ch 1 in the last loop



R3-R50: Repeat Row 2

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



Attach the strap to the opening of the bag using a yarn needle and the remaining yarn ends. Leave 32 sts between both straps.
