Baby Bobble Blanket

MATERIALS

Honey Bunny Candy

A: 4 skeins of col 78 (Cool Blue)

B: 5 skeins of col 63 (Lilac)

Crochet hook 7 mm

Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny Candy**, Hobbii

85% Polyester, 15% Polyamide

100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

9 sts and 10 rows in sc = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

bpgc = back post double crochet

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

fpdc = front post double crochet

rep = repeat

RS = right side of work

sc = single crochet

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side of work

yo = yarn over hook

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 84 cm / 33"

Length: 91.5 cm / 36"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Any baby or toddler will love to snuggle in this soft, velvety blanket full of warmth and texture. Pick two fun colors to compliment their personalities. This will be one of those blankets they cherish for years to come. Blanket is worked flat in one piece, with bobbles worked from the wrong side. The edging is crocheted in the round and finished with front and back post ribbing.

INFO AND TIPS

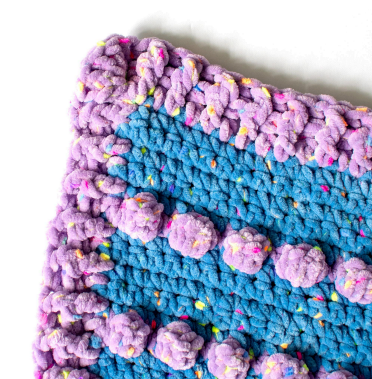
US crochet terms used throughout.

When single sts are worked one after another (without increasing or decreasing), this is given in the style "Xsc". For example, 5sc = sc in each of next 5 sts.

Front Post Double Crochet (fpdc): Yo, insert hook from front to back to the right of the next post, bring hook to front to the left of the post, yo and draw up a loop, [yo, draw through 2 loops] twice.

Back Post Double Crochet (bpdc): Yo, insert hook from back to front to the right of the next post, bring hook to back to the left of the post, yo and draw up a loop, [yo, draw through 2 loops] twice.

Make Bobble: [Yo, insert hook into st, yo and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops] 4 times, yo and draw through 5 loops on hook. Bobbles are worked on WS and visible on RS.





BLANKET

Section 1

With yarn A, ch76.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across. 75 sts

Row 2 (WS): Ch1 (does not count as st throughout), sc across.

Rows 3-5: Repeat Row 2 a further 3 times.

Fasten off yarn A.

Join yarn B on WS.

Bobble row (WS): Ch1, [1sc, make bobble, 1sc] across. Fasten off yarn B.

Join yarn A on RS.

Work 5 rows sc in yarn A.

Repeat Bobble row with yarn B once more.

Work 5 rows sc in yarn A.

Section 2

Join yarn B on RS.

[Work 5 rows sc in yarn B, work Bobble row with yarn A] twice.

Work 5 rows sc in yarn B.

Sections 3-5

Repeat Section 1 and 2 once more.

Repeat Section 1 once more.



BORDER

Join yarn B to the short edge of the blanket, 1 st in from the corner.

Next round (RS): Ch3 (does not count as st), [work 73dc across short edge, work 5dc in last st placing a marker in 3rd dc, work 84dc across long edge working 1 st into each row end, work 5dc in 1st st of short edge placing a marker in 3rd dc] twice, join with sl st to beg ch.

Next round (RS): Ch3, *[1fpdc, 1bpdc] to 1 before marked st, 1fpdc, 5bpdc in marked st, [1fpdc, 1bpdc] to marked st, 5fpdc in marked st, [1bpdc, 1fpdc] to 1 before marked st, 1bpdc, 5fpdc in marked st, [1bpdc, 1fpdc] to marked st, 5bpdc in marked st, 1fpdc, 1bpdc, join with sl st.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.

Cut ends can be melted to prevent shedding by gently passing them over a lighter.
