MATERIALS


2 skeins of **Toucan** color 16
1 skein of **Acacia Print** color 04
1 skein of **Acacia** color 01

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US H/8
Safety eyes 18 mm
Stuffing
Stitch markers
Scissors

YARN QUALITY

 **Toucan**, Hobbii
100% Polyester
100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

 **Acacia**, Hobbii
51% acrylic, 49% cotton
100 g (3.5 oz) = 250 m (273 yds)

 **Acacia Print**, Hobbii
51% acrylic, 49% cotton
100 g (3.5 oz) = 250 m (273 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

Mc-magic circle
Sc-single crochet
Inc-increase
Dec-decrease
Blo-back loop only
Ss-slip stitch
St-stitch

MEASUREMENTS

Width: approx. 18 cm / 7"
Length: approx. 25 cm / 9.75"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is written in continuous rounds. Do not join rounds unless specifically stated.

When a color change is introduced, the pattern will simply state the color before those stitches. Continue using the color stated until another color is written.

After sewing each piece on, tie off and weave in ends unless specifically stated.

Pattern



INFO AND TIPS

The decreases and increases are staggered in order to not get a line or bend where we are in- or decreasing stitches, making the look smoother.

This pattern is written in continuous rounds. Do not join rounds unless specifically stated.

When a color change is introduced, the pattern will simply state the color before those stitches. Continue using the color stated until another color is written.

Body

Row 1: mc 8sc (8)

Row 2: Inc in each st (16)

Row 3: (Inc, sc)x8 (24)

Row 4: blo sc in each st (24)

Row 5-6: sc in each st (24)

Row 7: 6sc, (sc, Inc)x6, 6sc (30)

Row 8: 6sc, (2sc, Inc)x6, 6sc (36)

Insert eyes between rows 8 and 9 and approximately 10 stitches apart

Row 9: 6sc, (sc, Inc, 2sc)x6, 6sc (42)

Row 10: 6sc, (2sc, Inc, 2sc)x6, 6sc (48)

Row 11: (3sc, Inc, 4sc)x6 (54)

Row 12: (7sc, Inc, sc)x6 (60)

Row 13-34: sc in each st (60) (22 rows)

Row 35: (dec, 8sc)x6 (54)

Row 36: (5sc, dec, 2sc)x6 (48)

Row 37: (2sc, dec, 4sc)x6 (42)

Row 38: (5sc, dec)x6 (36)

Row 39: (2sc, dec, 2sc)x6 (30)

Row 40: (sc, dec, 2sc)x6 (24)

Row 41: (2sc, dec)x6 (18)

Stop here to stuff, making sure to accentuate the nose

Row 42: (dec, sc)x6 (12)

Row 43: Dec in each st (6)

Join with ss and finish off

Legs (make 4)

Row 1: mc 6sc (6)

Row 2: Inc in each st (12)

Row 3: (Inc, sc)x6 (18)

Row 4: sc in each st (18)

Join with ss and finish off, leaving long yarn tail for sewing

Ears (make 2)

Row 1: mc 6sc (6)

Row 2: sc in each st (6)

Row 3: Inc in each st (12)

Row 4: (Inc, sc)x6 (18)

Row 5: sc in each st (18)

Fold in half and ss across the bottom

Tail

Chain 15, turn, in 3rd ch from hook 13 hdc. Join with ss and leave long tail for sewing

Blanket

Make 15 basic granny squares and use the ss method to stitch them together in a 3x5 grid, then sc across the whole edge.

In multicoloured Acacia yarn and 4.5mm hook

Row 1: mc, ch 2 (counts as the 1st dc), 2 dc in the ring, ch 1, *3 dc in the ring, ch 1, repeat from * two times more, sl st to top of beg ch-2. (12 dc or 4 groups of 3 dc each)

Row 2: turn, sl st into the 1st ch-1 sp (might be a little tight, but you can do it), ch 2 (counts as 1st dc), (2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) all in the same ch-1 sp, *(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in the next ch-1 sp, repeat from * two times more, sl st to top of beg ch-2. (24 dc or 8 groups of 3 dc each)

Row 3: turn, sl st into the sp between the 3dc groups on the side (not the corner ch-1 sp), ch 2 (counts as 1st dc), 2 dc in the same sp, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in the next ch-1 sp at the corner, *3 dc in the next sp between the 3dc groups on the side, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in the next ch-1 sp at the corner, repeat from * around, sl st to top of beg ch-2.

Row 4: turn, sl st into the sp between the next two 3dc groups on the side, ch 2 (counts as 1st dc), 2 dc in the same sp, *(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in the next ch-1 sp at the corner, 3 dc between each 3dc group on the side until the next ch-1 sp corner is reached or beginning 3dc group if you were in the middle of a side when the round began, repeat from * around, sl st to top of beg ch-2.

Repeat this process 15 times and when done with all 15 granny squares, lay them out in a 3x5 formation and use the white yarn to slip stitch them together. Finally use the white Acacia to sc a border around the entire piece, making it look crisp and clean. Don't forget to weave in your ends!
