Peppermint

MATERIALS

2 skeins of **Toucan** color 15
1 skein of **Toucan** color 01

1 skein of **Friends Cotton 8/4 Mercerized**
col. 124

A string of white yarn for detailing of the eye

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US H/8
Crochet hook 3.5 mm / US E/4
Stuffing
Stitch markers
Scissors
Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Toucan**, Hobbii
100% Polyester
100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

 **Friends Cotton 8/4 Mercerized**, Hobbii
100% Mercerized Cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (174 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

Mc-magic circle
Sc-single crochet
Inc-increase
Dec-decrease
Blo-back loop only
Ss-slip stitch
St-stitch

MEASUREMENTS

Width (of the body): approx. 23 cm / 9"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is written in continuous rounds.
Do not join rounds unless specifically stated.

When a color change is introduced, the pattern will simply state the color before those stitches. Continue using the color stated until another color is written.

The eyes are crocheted. After sewing each piece on, tie off and weave in ends unless specifically stated.

INFO AND TIPS

The decreases and increases are staggered in order to not get a line or bend where we are in- or decreasing stitches, making the look smoother.

This pattern is written in continuous rounds. Do not join rounds unless specifically stated.

When a color change is introduced, the pattern will simply state the color before those stitches. Continue using the color stated until another color is written.

Body (start with white)

With a 4.5 mm hook

Row 1: Mc 6sc (6)

Row 2: (white inc, red inc)x3 (12)

Row 3: [(Inc, sc) white (inc, sc) red]x3 (18)

Row 4: [(sc, Inc, sc) white (sc, inc, sc) red]x3 (24)

Row 5: [(3sc, Inc) white (3sc, inc) red]x3 (30)

Row 6: [(sc, Inc, 3sc) white (sc, inc, 3sc) red]x3 (36)

Row 7: [(4sc, Inc, sc) white (4sc, inc, sc) red]x3 (42)

Row 8: [(2sc, Inc, 4sc) white (2sc, inc, 4sc) red]x3 (48)

Row 9: [(Inc, 7sc) white (inc, 7sc) red]x3 (54)

Row 10: [(5sc, Inc, 3sc) white (5sc, inc, 3sc) red]x3 (60)

Row 11: [(3sc, Inc, 6sc) white (3sc, inc, 6sc) red]x3 (66)

Row 12: [(7sc, Inc, 3sc) white (7sc, inc, 3sc) red]x3 (72)

Row 13: [(11sc Inc) white (11sc, inc) red]x3 (78)

Row 14: [(5sc, Inc, 7sc) white (5sc, inc, 7sc) red]x3 (84)

Row 15: [(9sc, Inc, 4sc) white (9sc, inc, 4sc) red]x3 (90)

Row 16: [(14sc, Inc) white (14sc, inc) red]x3 (96) (this is the last row with white cut the white strand and tie off)

Row 17: blo sc in each st (96)

Row 18-21: sc in each st (96) (4 rows)

Row 22: (10sc, dec, 4sc)x6. (90)

Row 23: (3sc, dec, 10sc)x6 (84)

Row 24: (7sc, dec, 5sc)x6 (78)

Row 25: (dec, 11sc)x6 (72)

Row 26: (5sc, dec, 5sc)x6 (66)

Row 27: (2sc, dec, 7sc)x6 (60)

Row 28: (7sc, dec, sc)x6 (54)

Row 29: (4sc, dec, 3sc)x6 (48)

Row 30: (4sc, Dec, 2sc)x6 (42)

Row 31: (Dec, 5sc)x6 (36)

Row 32: (2sc, Dec, 2sc)x6 (30)

Row 33: (3sc, Dec)x6 (24)

Row 34: (sc, Dec, sc)x6 (18)

Stop here to stuff the whole body, making sure to stuff in a way that compliments the round yet flat shape of your peppermint

Row 35: (dec, sc)x6 (12)

Row 36: dec in each (6)

Join with ss and finish off

Feet (in red) (make 2)

With a 4.5 mm hook

Row 1: mc 6sc (6)

Row 2: Inc in each st (12)

Row 3: (Inc, sc)x6 (18)

Row 4: (sc, Inc, sc)x6 (24)

Row 5-7: sc in each st (24) (3 rows)

Row 8: (dec, 2sc)x6 (18)

Join with ss and finish off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing. stuff firmly.

Arms (in red, make 2)

With a 4.5 mm hook

Row 1: mc 6sc (6)

Row 2: Inc in each st (12)

Row 3: (Inc, sc)x6 (18)

Row 4-5: sc in each st (18)

Row 6: (dec, sc)x6 (12)

Row 7-14: sc in each st (12) (8 rows)

Join with ss and finish off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing. stuff firmly.

Eyes

With Friends Cotton 8/4 Mercerized col. 124 and a 3.5 mm hook (make 2)

Row 1: mc 6 sc (6)

Row 2: inc in each st (12)

Row 3: (sc, inc)x6 (18)

Row 4: (sc, inc, sc)x4, sc, inc, white 2sc, inc, black sc (24)

Row 5: (3sc, inc)x6 (30)

Join with ss and finish off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing

Assembly

First, position the arms at both sides of the peppermint base and halfway up, making sure they are level with one another. Then sew on with the yarn tails and yarn needle, tying off and weaving in ends. Next, position the legs at the base of the peppermint body and slightly apart, using the photos as a reference. Sew on with yarn tails and weave in ends.

Finally, place the eyes in the center of the peppermint and in line with the arms, again using the photos as a reference for positioning. Sew on with yarn tails and weave in ends.
