Edvin

Tote Bag

MATERIALS

Acacia

1 skein of color 03 (Double Cream) 1 skein of color 09 (Navy)

Circular needle 3.5 mm, 80 cm /US 4, 32"
Tapestry needle
Scissors
Measuring tape
4 stitch markers (1 unique marker to denote beginning of round)

YARN QUALITY

Acacia, Hobbii 51% Acrylic, 49% Cotton 100 g / 3.5 oz = 250 m / 273 yds

GAUGE

Gauge will vary by stitch type. Fabric will stretch greatly. Thus, gauge is not important, although it may affect the amount of yarn needed. See finished measurements.

ABBREVIATIONS

BOR = beginning of round k = knit k2tog = knit two together p = purl M1L = make 1 left M1R = make 1 right rnds = Rounds m = marker pm = place marker sm = slip marker ssk = slip, slip, knit yo = yarn over

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 34 cm / 13.5"

Length: 34 cm / 13.5" (without handle), 51 cm / 20"

long (with handle)

PATTERN INFORMATION

Trips to the farmer's market never looked so good. Breeze through the Edvin Tote, a knit pattern that you won't be able to put down! Featuring sections of lace and textured stitches, it's a feast for the eyes. Beginners will appreciate the chance to learn new stitch patterns, while seasoned knitters can relax into a project that is equal parts mindful and practical. Made with an acrylic and cotton blend yarn, it's machine washable and always ready for your next adventure.

INFO AND TIPS

Bag does not need to be blocked. Fabric will be stretchy, ideal for use as a shopping or beach tote.

CONSTRUCTION

Holding col. 03 and col. 09 together, cast on 50 stitches using preferred cast-on method. Do not join.

Knit 12 rows in garter stitch.

To join in the round: Pick up and knit 6 stitches along nearest side edge, pick up and knit 50 stitches along cast-on edge, pick up and knit 6 stitches along next side edge, place BOR marker and join to work in the round. 112 stitches.

Knit 3 rounds in stockinette stitch.

Begin first pattern section:

Round 1: K4, pm, (yo, ssk, k1) 16 times, pm, k8, pm, (yo, ssk, k1) 16 times, pm, knit to end.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: K4, sm, k1, (yo, ssk, k1) to 2 stitches before m, k2, sm, knit to next marker, sm, k1, (yo, ssk, k1) to 2 stitches before m, k2, sm, knit to end.

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: K4, sm, k2, (yo, ssk, k1) to 1 stitch before m, k1, sm, knit to next marker, sm, k2, (yo, ssk, k1) to 1 stitch before m, k1, sm, knit to end.

Round 6: Knit.

Repeat Rounds 1-6 one more time.

Knit 1 round, removing all stitch markers except BOR marker.

Purl 3 rounds.

Knit 1 round.



Cut col. 03. Continue with col. 09.

Begin second pattern section:

Round 1: K3, pm, k1, yo, k2tog, (k3, yo, k2tog) 9 times, pm, k10, pm, k1, yo, k2tog, (k3, yo, k2tog) 9 times, pm, knit to end.

Round 2: K3, sm, k2tog, yo, (k3, k2tog, yo) to 1 stitch before m, k1, sm, k10, sm, k2tog, yo, (k3, k2tog, yo) to 1 stitch before m, k1, sm, knit to end.

Work Rounds 1 and 2 a total of 8 times (16 rows).

With col. 03 and col. 09 together:

Knit 1 round, removing all stitch markers except BOR marker.

Purl 3 rounds.

Knit 1 round.

Cut col. 09. Continue with col. 03.

Begin third pattern section:

Next round: K4, pm, (yo, k2tog) 24 times, pm, k8, pm, (yo, k2tog) 24 times, pm, knit to end. Work last round 19 more times (20 times total).

Begin fourth pattern section:

With col. 03 and col. 09 together:

Knit 1 round.

Purl 3 rounds.

Next round: K4, sm, (yo, k2tog) 24 times, sm, k8, sm, (yo, k2tog) 24 times, sm, knit to end. Work last round 17 more times (18 times total).

Knit 1 round, removing all stitch markers except BOR marker.

Purl 3 rounds.

Bind off as follows: Bind off as follows: K2, slip 2 stitches from right needle to left needle, k2tog through the backloop, *k1, slip 2 stitches from left needle to right needle, k2tog through the backloop; repeat from * until 6 stitches remain (1 stitch on the right needle; 5 stitches on the left needle), then knit the remaining 5 stitches. 6 stitches remain.

HANDLE

Knit every row (garter stitch) for 35 cm / 14". Bind off.

SEAMING

Sew bound-off edge of handle to opposite side of bag.
