MATERIALS

Amigo

1 skein of col. 47 - Yarn A

1 skein of col. 29 - Yarn B

1 skein of col. 16 - Yarn C

Needles 3.25 mm, 20 cm / US 3, 8"
Stuffing
3x 8mm safety eyes
Black yarn or embroidery thread for nose and mouth.
Sewing up needle
Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Amigo, Hobbii 100 % Acrylic, 50 g / 0.1.75 oz = 175 m / 191 yds

GAUGE

26 sts x 30 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4'' x 4'' in stockinette stitches

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 9cm / 3.25" tall (Excluding the ears)

PATTERN INFORMATION

These cute little Easter Bunnies will look great decorating your home or will be perfect little gifts to find on an Easter Egg Hunt!

All parts are knitted flat and sewn together before stuffing.

This is a super quick and easy pattern - ideal for last minute gifts.

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = Cast on

k = knit

p = purl

kfb = knit into front and then back of the same stitch (Increase 1 stitch)

K2tog = Knit the following 2 stitches together. (Decrease 1 stitch)

P2tog = Purl the following 2 stitches together. (Decrease 1 stitch)

stst = Stockinette stitches: k 1 row, p 1 row. (Makes 2 rows) Pattern indicates whether to start with a k or p row.

rep = repeat

BO = bind off (Cast Off)

C&T = cut yarn and thread through remaining stitches. Slide stitches off the needle.

BODY

Cast on 7 sts

Leave a long yarn tail for sewing up.

Row 1 K1, *kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [12 sts]

Row 2 Purl.

Row 3 K1 *k1, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [17 sts]

Row 4 Purl.

Row 5 K1, *k2, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [22 sts]

Row 6 Purl.

Row 7 K1, *k3, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [27 sts]

Row 8 Purl.



Row 9 K1, *k4, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [32 sts]

Row 10 Purl.

Row 11 K1, *k5, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [37 sts]

Row 12 Purl.

Row 13 K1, *k6, kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [42 sts]

Rows 14-22 Stst 9 rows, starting with a P row.

Row 23 K1, *k6, k2tog, rep from* to last st, k1. [37 sts]

Row 24 Purl. Place stitch markers on 16th and 22nd stitches for eye placement.

Row 25 Knit.

Row 26 P1, *p5, p2tog, rep from * to last st, p1. [32 sts]

Row 27 Knit

Row 28 Purl.

Row 29 K1, *k4, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [27 sts]

Row 30 -31 Stst 2 rows, starting with a Purl row.

Row 32 P1, *p3, p2tog, rep from * to last st, p1. [22 sts]

Row 33 - 34 Stst 2 rows, starting with a knit row.

Row 35 K1, *k2, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [17 sts]

Row 36 Purl.

Row 37 K1, *k1, k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [12 sts]

Row 38 Purl.

Row 39 K1, *k2tog rep from * to last st, k1. [7 sts]

Row 40 C&T

Legs - Make two

Cast on 7 sts

Row 1 K1, *kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [12 sts]

Row 2 Purl.

Row 3 K1, kfb, k to last 2sts, kfb, k1. [14 sts]

Rows 4 -6 Stst 3 rows, starting with a P row.

Row 7 K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1. [16 sts]

Rows 8 -14 Stst 7 rows, starting with a P row.



Row 15 *K1, k2tog, rep from * to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. [11 sts]

Row 16 Purl.

Row 17 *K2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [6 sts]

Row 18 C&T.

Arms - Make two

Cast on 7sts using 3.25mm needles and YA, B or C.

Row 1 K1, *kfb, rep from * to last st, k1. [12 sts]

Rows 2 -12 Stst 11 rows, starting with a P row.

Row 13 K1, *k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [7 sts]

Row 14 C&T.

Ears - Make two

Cast on 10 sts using 3.25mm needles and YA, B or C.

Row 1 K to last st, kfb. [11]

Row 2 Kfb, k to end of row. [12]

Row 3 K to last st, kfb. [13]

Row 4 Kfb, k to end of row. [14]

Row 5 K to last st, kfb. [15]

Row 6 Kfb, k to end of row. [16]

Row 7 Knit.

Row 8 K2tog, k to end of row. [15]

Row 9 K to last 2sts, k2tog. [14]

Row 10 K2tog, k to end of row. [13]

Row 11 K to last 2sts, k2tog. [12]

Row 12 K2tog, k to end of row. [11]

Row 13 K to last 2sts, k2tog. [10]

Row 14 BO.



Making up

Safety eyes

Attach the eyes before sewing up the body.

The safety eyes are positioned at each of the stitch markers on row 24.

Carefully push the stem of each safety eye through the loop at each stitch marker- remove the marker.

Place some stuffing around each stem before pushing the plastic backing covers over the eye stems to hold the eyes in place.

Body

Use the CO yarn end to gather the CO on stitches, then mattress stitch the seam stopping 2 cm from the C&T row.

Stuff the bunny firmly, paying attention to the shaping. Finish sewing the side seam, add more stuffing to the open top of the bunny before pulling the C&T yarn to close the top. Weave in the yarn end.

Nose and mouth

Position the nose just under the eyes in the middle of the body. Use black yarn to make horizontal stitches 2 stitches wide and 2 rows high. Add a mouth shaped as an upside-down capitol T. The vertical bar is 4 rows long and the edge of each side of the mouth is 2 rows up and 2 stitches to the side of the vertical bar.





Ears

Fold each ear in half lengthways and sew the row ends together at the straight row ends. Position the ears on the top of the head as shown, sew firmly into place.

Arms

Gather CO edge. With wrong sides together mattress stitch the arm seam. Stuff the arm and pull the C&T yarn to close the top of the arm.

Position an arm either side of the body, level with the eyes. Sew securely in place.

Legs

Gather CO edge. With wrong sides together mattress stitch the leg seam. Stuff the leg and pull the C&T yarn to close the bottom of the leg.

Position the C&T end of a leg either side of the body, approx. 2cm from the middle of the base. Use the illustration to guide you for sewing the legs into place.



Tail

Make a small pom from leftover yarn and sew into place at the back of the bunny.
