## **MATERIALS**

## Friends Cotton 8/4

1 skein of Olive (109)

1 skein of Blush (36)

1 skein of Dusty Mauve (58)

Embroidery yarn color 900

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2 Crochet hook 3.5 mm / US E/4 Stitch markers Yarn needle 10 mm Safety Eyes Filling

# **YARN QUALITY**

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100 % Cotton 50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 174 yds

#### **GAUGE**

21 sts x 26 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

mr = magic ring

inc = increase

dec = decrease (invisible)

sl st = slip stitch

hdc = half double crochet

blo = back loop only

#### SIZE

One size

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 10 cm / 4" Length: 15 cm / 6"

Meet Poppy the bunny! This is an adorable crochet pattern that lets you make your own cute little bunny dressed as a carrot for Easter! Poppy has big, floppy ears, a sweet little blush-colored hat with green leaves on top (just like a real carrot), and a matching collar. With her round black eyes and cozy carrot costume, she's a fun and cute project for anyone who loves bunnies and springtime!

# **Pattern**







## **HEAD**

Start with hook 2,5 mm and color Dusty Mauve (58).

Make a mr and crochet in spiral

R1: sc 6 (6)

R2: inc 6 (12)

R3: (sc, inc) x6 times (18)

R4: (sc 2, inc) x6 times (24)

R5: (sc 3, inc) x6 times (30)

R6: (sc 4, inc) x6 times (36)

R7: (sc 5, inc) x6 times (42)

R8: (sc 6, inc) x6 times (48)

R9: (sc 7, inc) x6 times (54)

R10: (sc 8, inc) x6 times (60)

R11-R19: sc 60 (60)

Place the safety eyes between rounds 13 and 16, making sure there are 7 stitches between them.

R20: (sc 8, dec) x6 times (54)

R21: (sc 7, dec) x6 times (48)

R22: (sc 6, dec) x6 times (42)

R23: (sc 5, dec) x6 times (36)

R24: (sc 4, dec) x6 times (30)

Embroider with yarn needle the nose between rounds 17 and 19, making sure it is centered between the eyes.

R25: (sc 3, dec) x6 times (24)

R26: (sc 2, dec) x6 times (18)

R27: sc all (18)

Stuff the head with filling.



#### **BODY**

Continue without cutting the yarn.

R28: (inc, sc) x9 times (27)

R29: (inc, sc 2) x9 times (36)

R30-R32: sc all (36)

R33: (inc, sc 3) x9 times (45)

R34: (inc, sc 4) x9 times (54)

R35-R43: sc all (54)

R44: (dec, sc 4) x9 times (45)

R45: (dec, sc 3) x9 times (36)

Do not fasten off.



#### **LEGS**

To create the legs, start by dividing the stitches. Mark 4 stitches in the centre to create space between the legs (2 stitches at the front centre and 2 at the back centre). Then, mark 14 stitches for each leg using stitch markers will help keep these sections clear. For the first leg, join the marked stitch for the leg on the back to the marked stitch in the front by working a single crochet stitch, this will be the first stitch of the leg. Now that you have joined the stitches of the first leg in a round, continue crocheting the first leg as follows:

R46-R47: sc all (14)

R48: (5 sc, dec)x 2 times (12)

R49: (dec)x 6 times (6)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Close the remaining hole with a yarn needle by weaving the yarn tail through each remaining stitch and pulling tight to close. Weave the yarn end. Stuff the body and leg with filling.

For the second leg, rejoin the yarn in the fifth unworked stitch at the back. This is where we start the first stitch of the second leg. Leave a long starting yarn tail.

R46-R47: sc all (14)

R48: (5 sc, dec)x 2 times (12)

R49: (dec)x 6 times (6)

Stuff the second leg with filling and close the remaining hole using the same method as with the first leg. Finally, use the starting yarn tail from the second leg to sew the 4 central stitches between the legs closed, completing the body.





## EARS (MAKE 2)

With color Dusty Mauve (58).

Make a mr and crochet in spiral

R1: sc 6 (6)

R2: (1 sc, inc)x3 times (9)

R3: (2 sc, inc)x 3 times (12)

R4: (3 sc, inc)x 3 times (15)

R5: (4 sc, inc)x 3 times (18)

R6: (5 sc, inc)x 3 times (21)

R7: (6 sc, inc)x 3 times (24)

R8: (7 sc, inc)x 3 times (27)

R9: (8 sc, inc)x 3 times (30)

R10: (9 sc, inc)x 3 times (33)

R11: (10 sc, inc)x 3 times (36)

R12-R16: sc all (36)

R17: (10 sc, dec)x 3 times (33)

R18-R20: sc all (33)

R21: (9 sc, dec)x 3 times (30)

R22-R23: sc all (30)

R24: (8 sc, dec)x 3 times (27)

R25-26: sc all (27)

R27: (7 sc, dec)x 3 times (24)

R28-29: sc all (24)

R30: (6 sc, dec)x 3 times (21)

R31-32: sc all (21)

R33: (5 sc, dec)x 3 times (18)


R34-R36: sc all (18)

R37: (4 sc, dec)x 3 times (15)

R38-R40: sc all (15)

Do not stuff the ears. Leave a long tail for sewing. Pinch the top of the ears and with a yarn needle sew between rounds 9 and 10, leaving 24 sts between them.





# **HAT**

Change to a 3.5 mm hook and color Blush (36).

Ch 11. Crochet in rows.

R1: starting from the 2nd ch from the hook, hdc 10 (10)

R2-R22: ch 1, turn, hdc blo all (10)

For the ribbing, ch 1, crochet 22 sc sts on the side of the hat.

R1-2: ch 1, turn, sc all (22)



Join the first and last rows with slip stitches.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for closing the top. Weave a yarn needle through each stitch around the final row at the top of the hat. Once you've gone all the way around, gently pull the yarn to tighten and close the top.



For the leaves, use Olive (109) and your 3.5 mm hook. Make 3.



Ch 15. R1: from the 2nd ch from the hook, sc 5, ch 5, sc 4, then sl st 9. Fasten off.



Attach to the top of the hat using the yarn ends.

# **COLLAR**

Use a 3.5 mm hook and color Blush (36).

R1: from the 2nd ch from the hook, sl st 15, (skip one st, dc 5, skip one st, sl st) x 4 times, sl st 15. Fasten off and weave the ends.
