



CROCHET PATTERN

Crocus

Design: One Crafty Magpie | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

Rainbow Cotton 8/4, 1 skein of each colour:

Grey Brown (005), Beige (004), Dusty Green (023), Egg Yolk (090), Dusty Purple (068), Purple (039), Natural White (002)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US 4/0

Stitch marker

Scissors

Yarn Needle

Stuffing

Pins

1 pair of safety eyes 7mm

Scrap of pink yarn to make a blush

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100 % cotton, super fine

50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

Gauge is not important for this project

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Crocus: approx. 12cm / 4.75" high (without roots)

Pot: approx. 4 cm / 1.5" high

PATTERN INFORMATION

This crochet amigurumi crocus pattern is perfect for bringing the joy of spring into your craft projects. The pattern allows for customization of colours, so you can recreate traditional purple and yellow crocuses or experiment with unique hues. Ideal as a decorative piece, these crocheted flowers can brighten up seasonal displays. With clear instructions, the pattern is suitable for both beginners and experienced crocheters looking for a fun, nature-inspired project!

INFO AND TIPS

- Read the pattern before starting to crochet.
- Crochet in continuous, spiral rounds unless otherwise stated in the pattern.
- Stuff your amigurumi firmly as you go.
- Try to make tight stitches to avoid the holes.
- Always mark the beginning of each round using a stitch marker
- Pattern doesn't contain tutorials for stitches

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet, I use "x" shaped single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

BLO = work the stitch in the back loop only

FLO = work the stitch in the front loop only

scinc = work 2sc in the same st to increase

scdec = invisible single crochet decrease (crochet 2 sts together in only front loops)

Rnd/Rnds = round/rounds

slst = slip stitch

st/sts = stitch/stitches

(..) = number of stitches at the end of the round

BULB

Start with col. 004. Stuff as you go.

Rnd 1: MR, 6sc (6)

Rnd 2: scinc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

Rnd 6: (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

Rnd 7: (5sc, scinc) x6 (42)

Rnd 8: (6sc, scinc) x6 (48)

Rnd 9: (7sc, scinc) x6 (54)

Rnd 10 – Rnd 15: 1sc in each stitch around – 6 rounds (54)

Rnd 16: (7sc, scdec) x6 (48)

Rnd 17: 1sc in each stitch around (48)

Rnd 18: (6sc, scdec) x6 (42)

Rnd 19: 1sc in each stitch around (42)

Rnd 20: (5sc, scdec) x6 (36)

Rnd 21: 1sc in each stitch around (36)

Insert the eyes between Rnd 11- Rnd 12 with 8 visible stitches apart. Using a scrap of pink yarn, embroider a blush. Start stuffing and stuff as you go.

Rnd 22: (4sc, scdec) x6 (30)

Rnd 23: (3sc, scdec) x6 (24)

Rnd 24: (2sc, scdec) x6 (18)

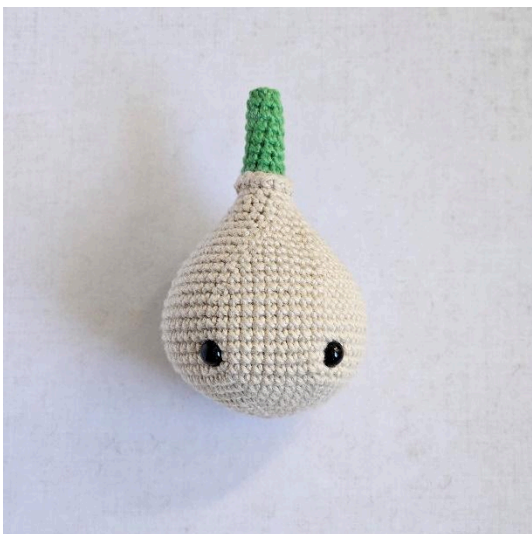
Rnd 25: 1sc in each stitch around (18)

Rnd 26: (1sc, scdec) x6 (12)

Rnd 27: 1sc in each stitch around (12)

Rnd 28: FLO, 1sc in each stitch around (12)

Fasten off, weave in the end.



STEM

Attach col. 023 into any BL stitch of Rnd 28. Stuff firmly as you go.

Rnd 29: BLO, 1sc in each stitch around (12)

Rnd 30 – Rnd 34: 1sc in each stitch around - 5 rounds (12)

Rnd 35: scdec x6 (6)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

STAMENS (make 3)

With col. 090



Ch8

Make 3sc into the second chain from the hook, then make 1slst into each of the 6 remaining chains. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

PETALS (make 6, three of each colour)

With col. 068 and col. 039



Ch10, start with the second chain from the hook.

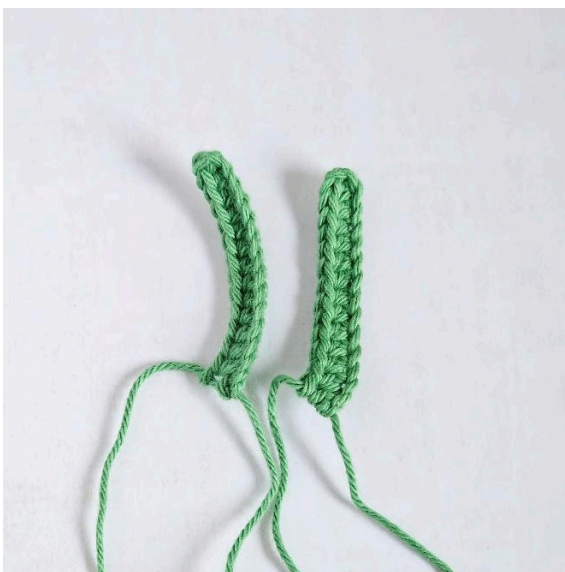
Rnd 1: 3sc, 5hdc, 6hdc into the last st. Now we're going to work on the other side of the foundation chain, 5hdc, 3sc (22 sts)

Rnd 2: 3sc, 5hdc, hdcinc x6, 5hdc, 3sc (28 sts)

Slst into the first sc. Fasten off leaving a long tail.

LEAVES (make 2)

With col. 023



Ch15, start with a second chain from the hook. Make 1hdc into each of the remaining chains.

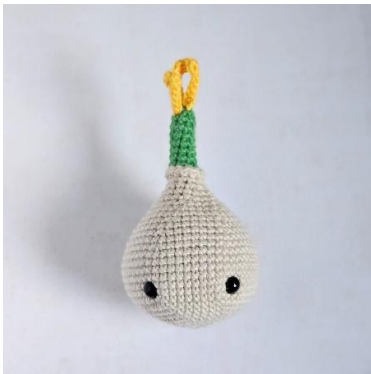
Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Assembly

Sew the stamens into the top of the stem. Sew the leaves into the bottom of the stem.

Use the pins to position petals around the stamens and sew them tightly.

Now you can add some roots. To do so, make a few safety knots with the col. 002 on the bottom of the bulb, cut for the desired length and brush lightly.



BASKET

With a col. 005

Rnd 1: MR, 6sc (6)

Rnd 2: scinc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

Rnd 6: (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

Rnd 7: (5sc, scinc) x6 (42)

Rnd 8: (6sc, scinc) x6 (48)

Rnd 9: (7sc, scinc) x6 (54)

Rnd 10: BLO, 1sc in each stitch around (54)

Rnd 11 - Rnd 13: 1sc in each stitch around - 3 rounds (54)

Rnd 14: (8sc, scinc) x6 (60)

Rnd 15 – Rnd 18: 1sc in each stitch around – 4 rounds (60)

Rnd 19: (9sc, scinc) x6 (66)

Rnd 20 – Rnd 22: 1sc in each stitch around – 3 rounds (66)

Rnd 23: ch14 (skip 8 stitches), 25sc, ch14 (skip 8 stitches), 25sc (78)

Rnd 24: 78slst (78)

Fasten off and weave in all ends.
