For the Egg:

Portobello

1 ball of color 04

1 ball of color 56

Crochet hook 4.0 mm / G-6 Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C

Embroidery yarn color 347 2 safety eyes 6 mm Stuffing Stitch marker

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4 Mercerized, Hobbii 100% Cotton 50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 174 yds

Portobello, Hobbii
60% Cotton, 28% Acrylic, 12% Wool
50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: Approx. 12 cm / 4.75"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Please note that this is a crochet pattern (PDF file). This crochet pattern contains a detailed description of how to create Easter Chicken in the surprise egg, with a great amount of step-by-step photos and a list of necessary materials. The chicken is crocheted from top to bottom as a one piece. The wings, comb, tail and wattle are crocheted separately and sewn onto the body and head. Pattern level: intermediate and also for beginners (with some crochet experience). Pattern is included to use two sizes of crochet hooks: 4.0 mm / G-6 and 2.5 mm / US C.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dec = invisible decrease (2 sc together in front loop only)

inc = increase (2 sc in one stitch)

hdc = half double crochet stitch

mr = magic ring

slst = slip stitch

FLO = use only front loops

BLO = use only back loops

Pic = picture

HEAD

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with Cream (04) color.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 (12)

Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: (inc, 3 sc) x6 (30)

Rnd 6-10: sc around (30), 5 rounds

Rnd 11: 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc (36)

Attach the safety eyes between round 10 and 11 with 7 sts between (pic 1).

Skip 4 sts from the beginning (count the sts of round 10), attach the first eye, then skip the next 7 sts and attach the second eye.

Rnd 12-13: sc around (36), 2 rounds

Rnd 14: 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc (42)

Rnd 15: sc around (42)

Change the yarn to Sunflower (24) and place the cream yarn on the front from your work (pic

2). We will use it to make the edging after we finish the body.

Stuff the head firmly.



BODY

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with Sunflower (24) color

Rnd 16: BLO (use only back loops): sc around (42)

Rnd 17: sc around (42)

Rnd 18: (6 sc, inc) x6 (48)

Rnd 19-20: sc around (48), 2 rounds

Rnd 21: (7 sc, inc) x3, 12 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 7 sc (54)

Rnd 22: 41 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 8 sc (57)

Rnd 23: 43 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 9 sc (60)

Rnd 24-25: sc around (60), 2 rounds

Rnd 26: 41 sc, 6 dec, 7 sc (54)

Rnd 27-29: sc around (54), 3 rounds

Rnd 30: (7 sc, dec) x6 (48)

Start to stuff the body.

Rnd 31: (6 sc, dec) x6 (42)

Rnd 32: (5 sc, dec) x6 (36)

Rnd 33: (4 sc, dec) x6 (30)

Rnd 34: (3 sc, dec) x6 (24)

Rnd 35: (2 sc, dec) x6 (18)

Rnd 36: (sc, dec) x6 (12)

Stuff the body firmly (pic 4).

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing. Invisible fasten off (pic 3).

EDGING

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with Cream (04) color.

Lay the body so that the eyes and belly will be on the right side and facing away (pic 5). Insert your hook in the last front loop of round 16. Pick up the Cream (04) yarn and pull it through. Make the next combination: (chain 4, slst in next 2 front loops), repeat it 20 times (pic 6-8). Chain 4, slst in last and first front loops.

Cut the yarn, fasten off.

BEAK

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with Dark Orange (26) color.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 2: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 3: ch 1, (sc, inc) x3, slst in first st (9)

Rnd 4: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (9)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing (pic 9).

Stuff the beak firmly.

COMB

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with Rose (44) color

First piece:

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 (9)

Rnd 3-4: sc around (9), 2 rounds

Cut the yarn, invisible fasten off (pic 10-11).

Second piece:



Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6) Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 (9) Rnd 3-5: sc around (9), 3 rounds Cut the yarn, invisible fasten off.

Now we are going to connect two pieces together (pic 12).

Rnd 1: Insert your hook from the wrong side of the right piece out to the left piece (pic 13). Pick up the yarn and pull it through. Chain 1, sc in the same connecting stitch of the left piece (count this stitch as the first stitch of round 1, put your stitch marker here (pic 14)), sc in next 8 st around the left piece. Then continue to crochet around the right piece: 9 sc [18]

Rnd 2: (dec, 4 sc) x3 (15)
Rnd 3: (dec, 3 sc) x3 [12]
Rnd 4: (dec, 2 sc) x3 (9)
Stuff the comb lightly (pic 15).
Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing.
Invisible fasten off (in the same way as we've closed the body).

TAIL

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with Lilac (63) color

First and second piece:

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6) Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 (9)

Rnd 3-4: sc around (9), 2 rounds

Cut the yarn, invisible fasten off (pic 10-11).

Now we are going to connect two pieces together.

Rnd 1: Insert your hook from the wrong side of the right piece out to the left piece. Pick up the yarn and pull it through. Chain 1, sc in the connecting stitch of the left piece (count this stitch as the first stitch of round 1, put your stitch marker here), sc in next 8 st around the left piece. Then continue to crochet around the right piece: 9 sc [18]

Rnd 2: sc around (18) Rnd 3: (dec, 4 sc) x3 (15) Rnd 4: (dec, 3 sc) x3 (12) Rnd 5: (dec, 2 sc) x3 (9) Stuff the tail lightly.

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing (pic 16).

WATTLE

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with Lilac (63) color.

Chain 8. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Rnd 1: start in second chain from the hook: 3 hdc in this stitch, sc in next 2 st, slst in next st, sc in next 2 st, 3 hdc in last st (pic 17).

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing. Use the needle, bring the tail of yarn to the middle of the wattle.

WINGS (make 2)

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with Rose (44) color.



Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 (12)

Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)

Don't cut the yarn, we're going to crochet the feathers.

Chain 2, start in the second chain from hook: slst. It would be the first feather (pic 18-19).

Then fold the circle in half, crochet a sc across the first and last stitch (pic 20).

Again, chain 2, start in the second chain from the hook: slst, sc in next st, repeat it 11 times (pic 21).

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing.

For the second wing, use the needle, bring the tail of the yarn in the opposite of the wing.

ASSEMBLING

- Sew the beak between the eyes and round 10 and 14 (pic 24).
- Place the wattle below the beak and sew the wattle to the head. You should sew it only on the top (pic 25).
- Sew the comb on the top of the head (pic 26).
- Place the tail on the back side of the body and sew it between round 25 and 27 (pic 27-28).
- Place the wings in diagonal. You should sew it to the body only on the top of the wing (pic 29-30).
- At last, use the pink thread, embroider the cheeks below the eyes (pic 31).

Eggs (small)

Use a hook 2,5 mm, work with white (01), Lilac (63), Sunflower (24), Rose (44) colors.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 (9)

Rnd 3: (2 sc, inc) x3 (12)

Rnd 4: (3 sc, inc) x3 (15)

Rnd 5-9: sc around (15), 5 rounds

Rnd 10: (dec, sc) x5 (10)

Stuff the eggs firmly.

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail.

Close the egg in the same way as the body.

Egg/outer/bottom part

Use a hook 4 mm, work with Portobello Wild Berry (56)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 2: ch 1, (inc) x6, slst in first st (12)

Rnd 3: ch 1, (inc, sc) x6, slst in first st (18)

Rnd 4: ch 1, (2 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (24)

Rnd 5: ch 1, (inc, 3 sc) x6, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 6: ch 1, 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 7: ch 1, BLO (use only back loops): sc around, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 8: ch 1, 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 9: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 10: ch 1, (6 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (48)



Rnd 11-12: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (48), 2 rounds

Rnd 13: ch 1, (15 sc, inc) x3, slst in first st (51)

Rnd 14-16: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (51), 3 rounds

Rnd 17: ch 1, sc around (51)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing.

Invisible fasten off (in the same way as we've closed the first and second piece of the comb (pic 32)).

Egg/inner/bottom part

Use a hook 4 mm, work with Portobello Cream (04)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 2: ch 1, (inc) x6, slst in first st (12)

Rnd 3: ch 1, (inc, sc) x6, slst in first st (18)

Rnd 4: ch 1, (2 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (24)

Rnd 5: ch 1, (inc, 3 sc) x6, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 6: ch 1, 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 7: ch 1, FLO: sc around, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 8: ch 1, 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 9-10: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (42), 2 rounds

Rnd 11: ch 1, (6 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 12-14: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (48), 3 rounds

Rnd 15: ch 1, (15 sc, inc) x3, slst in first st (51)

Rnd 16: ch 1, sc around (51)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing. Invisible fasten off.

Place the inner part inside of the outer part with the right side outside (pic 33). Insert your hook from inside to out across a stitch of inner and outer part, pick up the cream color yarn and pull it through. Again insert your hook in next 2 sts and make a slst (pic 34).

Connect the two parts of the bottom with slst in each stitch.

Cut the yarn, fasten off (pic 35).

Egg/outer/top part

Use a hook 4 mm, work with Portobello Wild Berry (56)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 2: ch 1, (inc) x6, slst in first st (12)

Rnd 3: ch 1, (inc, sc) x6, slst in first st (18)

Rnd 4: ch 1, (2 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (24)

Rnd 5: ch 1, (inc, 3 sc) x6, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 6: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 7: ch 1, 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 8: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 9: ch 1, 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 10: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 11: ch 1, (6 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 12: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 13: ch 1, (15 sc, inc) x3, slst in first st (51)

Rnd 14-21: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (51), 8 rounds

Rnd 22: ch 1, sc around (51)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing. Invisible fasten off.



Egg/inner/top part

Use a hook 4 mm, work with Cream (04) color

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 2: ch 1, (inc) x6, slst in first st (12)

Rnd 3: ch 1, (inc, sc) x6, slst in first st (18)

Rnd 4: ch 1, (2 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (24)

Rnd 5: ch 1, (inc, 3 sc) x6, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 6-7: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (30), 2 rounds

Rnd 8: ch 1, 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 9: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 10: ch 1, 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 11: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 12: ch 1, (6 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 13: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 14: ch 1, (15 sc, inc) x3, slst in first st (51)

Rnd 15-20: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (51), 6 rounds

Rnd 21: ch 1, sc around (51)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing. Invisible fasten off.

In the same way, place the inner part inside of the outer part with the right side outside. Then use the cream color yarn, connect the two parts together with the slip stitch. Cut the yarn, fasten off (pic 36).






