MATERIALS

For the Sheep:

Friends Cotton 8/4 Mercerized

1 ball of color 01

1 ball of color 04

1 ball of color 44

1 ball of color 108

For the Egg:

Portobello

1 ball of color 18

1 ball of color 53

Crochet hook 4.0 mm / G-6 Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C

2 safety eyes 6 mm Stuffing Stitch marker

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4 Mercerized, Hobbii 100% Cotton 50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 174 yds

Portobello, Hobbii 60% Cotton, 28% Acrylic, 12% Wool 50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: Approx. 10 cm / 4"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Please note that this is a crochet pattern (PDF file). This crochet pattern contains a detailed description of how to create Easter Sheep in the surprise egg, with a great amount of step-by-step photos and a list of necessary materials.

The sheep is crocheted from top to bottom as a one piece. The ears, legs, flower and leaf are crocheted separately and sewn onto the body and head.

Only basic crocheting skills will be needed: chain, single crochet, stitch/stitches, increase, decrease, half and double crochet stitches, use only front loops, use only black loop, fasten off.

Pattern level: intermediate and also for beginners (with some crochet experience). Pattern is included to use two sizes of crochet hooks: 4.0 mm / G-6 and 2.5 mm / US C.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dec = invisible decrease (2 sc together in front loop only)

inc = increase (2 sc in one stitch)

mr = magic ring

slst = slip stitch

hdc = half double crochet stitch

dc = double crochet stitch

inc dc = increase double crochet stitch (2 dc together in one stitch)

FLO = use only front loops

BLO = use only back loops

Pic = picture

HEAD and BODY

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with white color (01)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 (12)

Rnd 3: BLO (use only back loops): (inc, sc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: BLO: (inc, 3 sc) x6 (30)

Rnd 6: sc around (30)

Rnd 7: BLO: sc around (30)

Rnd 8: (4 sc, inc) x6 (36)

In the next few rounds we're going to work with two colors of yarn: white (01) and cream (04)

(pic 1-2).

Rnd 9: white yarn: BLO: 14 sc, cream yarn: BLO: 8 sc, white yarn: BLO: 14 sc (36)

Tip: give the tail of the previous yarn a nice tug when you change the color of yarn, to prevent loose stitches. You will notice the big loops at the back. Make sure that the loops are loose enough to stretch when you stuff the head and body (pic 3). Otherwise, you will have a scrunched sheep's face.

Rnd 10: white yarn: 14 sc, cream yarn: 8 sc, white yarn: 14 sc (36)



Rnd 11: white yarn: BLO: 14 sc, cream yarn (work in both loops): 8 sc, white yarn: BLO: 14 sc, (pic 4) (36)

Rnd 12: white yarn: 14 sc, cream yarn: 8 sc, white yarn: 14 sc (36)

Attach the safety eyes between round 11 and 12 with 5 sts between (pic 5). Skip 15 sts from the beginning (count the stitches of round 12), attach the first eye, then skip the next 5 sts and attach the second eye.

Rnd 13: white yarn: BLO: 14 sc, cream yarn (work in both loops): 8 sc, white yarn: BLO: 14 sc (36)

Cut the <u>cream</u> yarn and continue with white.

Rnd 14: (5 sc, inc) x6 (42)

Rnd 15: BLO: sc around (42)

Rnd 16: sc around (42)

Rnd 17: BLO: sc around (42)

Rnd 18: sc around (42)

Rnd 19: BLO: sc around (42)

Rnd 20: sc around (42)

Rnd 21: BLO: sc around (42)

Rnd 22: sc around (42)

Rnd 23: BLO: sc around (42)

Rnd 24: (dec, 5 sc) x6 (36)

Start to stuff the head and body firmly.

Rnd 25: BLO: (dec, 4 sc) x6 (30)

Rnd 26: (dec, 3 sc) x6 (24)

Rnd 27: (dec, 2 sc) x6 (18)

Rnd 28: (dec, sc) x6 (12)

Cut the yarn, leaving it for closing.

Stuff the body firmly (pic 8).

Invisible fasten off (pic 6-7).

FLEECE/HAIR

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with white color (01).

Hold the sheep's head up and facing you. Insert your hook in the first front loop of round 3 (pic 9). Pick up the white yarn and pull it through. Chain 4, slst in next loop (pic 10-11), repeat in all stitches around the head (pic 12). When you reach the face side, turn your work and continue making hair in the other direction (pic 13). Then, continue to crochet the hair around the body (pic 14-15).

LEGS (make 2)

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with cream color (04).

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 (9)

Rnd 3-7: sc around (9), 5 rounds

Don't stuff the legs.

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing (pic 16).

Invisible fasten off.



EARS (make 2)

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with white (01) and rose (44) colors. The ears are made by joining 2 circles.

Inner circle (rose color)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6) Rnd 2: (inc) x6 (12)

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end. Set aside.

Outer circle (white color)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 (12)

Do not fasten off. We will join both parts, placing the white circle on the rose circle with the wrong side together and facing you (pic 17). Insert your hook under both loops of both circles, pick up the white loop and pull it through (pic 18). Chain 1, again insert your hook in the same stitch, sc in this st, sc in next 11 sts.

Cut the yarn, invisible fasten off (pic 19). Leave a tail for sewing.

Fold the ear in half and sew the first few stitches together (pic 20-21).

FLOWER

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with rose (44) color.

Rnd 1: in magic ring: (ch 1, 2 dc, ch 1, slst) x5

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing (pic 22).

LEAF

Use a hook 2.5 mm, work with pistachio (108) color.

Chain 5. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Rnd 1: start in the second chain from the hook: sc, hdc, inc dc, 5 hdc in the last chain stitch.

Continue to crochet on the other side of the foundation chains: inc dc, hdc, sc.

Fasten off.

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing (pic 22).

ASSEMBLING

- 1. Place and sew the ears on both sides from the face on round 9 (pic 23).
- 2. Sew the leaf and flower on the top-right side of the head (pic 24).
- 3. Use pink embroidery thread, embroider the heart-shaped nose and cheeks. Use the black embroidery thread to embroider a thin line of a heart-shaped nose and mouth (pic 25-26).
- 4. At last, sew the legs on the bottom of the body (pic 27).

Egg/outer/bottom part

Use a hook 4 mm, work with Portobello red cedar (18) color.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 2: ch 1, (inc) x6, slst in first st (12)

Rnd 3: ch 1, (inc, sc) x6, slst in first st (18)

Rnd 4: ch 1, (2 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (24)

Rnd 5: ch 1, (inc, 3 sc) x6, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 6: ch 1, 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc, slst in first st (36)



Rnd 7: ch 1, BLO: sc around, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 8: ch 1, 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 9: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 10: ch 1, (6 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 11-12: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (48), 2 rounds

Rnd 13: ch 1, (15 sc, inc) x3, slst in first st (51)

Rnd 14-16: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (51), 3 rounds

Rnd 17: ch 1, sc around (51)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing.

Invisible fasten off (pic 29-30).

Egg/inner/bottom part

Use a hook 4 mm, work with Portobello antique rose (53) color.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 2: ch 1, (inc) x6, slst in first st (12)

Rnd 3: ch 1, (inc, sc) x6, slst in first st (18)

Rnd 4: ch 1, (2 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (24)

Rnd 5: ch 1, (inc, 3 sc) x6, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 6: ch 1, 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 7: ch 1, FLO (use only front loops): sc around, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 8: ch 1, 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 9-10: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (42), 2 rounds

Rnd 11: ch 1, (6 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 12-14: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (48), 3 rounds

Rnd 15: ch 1, (15 sc, inc) x3, slst in first st (51)

Rnd 16: ch 1, sc around (51)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing. Invisible fasten off.

Place the inner part inside of the outer part with the right side outside as shown in picture 31. Insert your hook from inside to out through a stitch of the inner and outer part, pick up the rose colored yarn (53) (pic 32) and pull it through. Make a slip stitch loosely. Again insert in next 2 sts and make a slst (pic 33).

Connect the two parts of the bottom with slst in each stitch. Fasten off (pic 33).

Egg/outer/top part

Use a hook 4 mm, work with red cedar (18) color.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 2: ch 1, (inc) x6, slst in first st (12)

Rnd 3: ch 1, (inc, sc) x6, slst in first st (18)

Rnd 4: ch 1, (2 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (24)

Rnd 5: ch 1, (inc, 3 sc) x6, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 6: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 7: ch 1, 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 8: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 9: ch 1, 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 10: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 11: ch 1, (6 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 12: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 13: ch 1, (15 sc, inc) x3, slst in first st (51)

Rnd 14-18: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (51), 5 rounds



Rnd 19: ch 1, sc around (51)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing. Invisible fasten off.

Egg/inner/top part

Use a hook 4 mm, work with antique rose (53) color.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr, slst in first st (6)

Rnd 2: ch 1, (inc) x6, slst in first st (12)

Rnd 3: ch 1, (inc, sc) x6, slst in first st (18)

Rnd 4: ch 1, (2 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (24)

Rnd 5: ch 1, (inc, 3 sc) x6, slst in first st (30)

Rnd 6-7: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (30), 2 rounds

Rnd 8: ch 1, 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 9: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (36)

Rnd 10: ch 1, 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 11: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (42)

Rnd 12: ch 1, (6 sc, inc) x6, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 13: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (48)

Rnd 14: ch 1, (15 sc, inc) x3, slst in first st (51)

Rnd 15-18: ch 1, sc around, slst in first st (51), 4 rounds

Rnd 19: ch 1, sc around (51)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for closing. Invisible fasten off.

In the same way, place the inner part inside of the outer part with the right side on the outside. Then use the rose colored yarn (53), connect the two parts together using the slip stitch (pic 31-34). Fasten off.




