

CROCHET PATTERN

Daila Top

Design: Noemoncrochet | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

(6, 6, 6) (7, 8, 9) skeins of **Olivin** color 15

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US 7 Scissors Yarn needle Tape measure Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Olivin, Hobbii 50% Cotton, 50% Linen 50g / 1.75 oz = 125 m /136 yds

GAUGE

15 hdc (blo) x 10 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

Important: All measurements given have been blocked.

SIZE

(XS, S, M) (L, XL, 2XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: (43, 47, 51) (55, 59, 63) cm / (17", 18.5", 20") (21.5", 23", 25")

Length: (46, 46, 48) (48, 52, 52) cm / (18", 18", 19") (19", 20.5", 20.5")

The top is designed to be worn with a positive ease of approx. 5 - 10 cm / 2" - 4" around the bust. The model is wearing a size L with approx. 10 cm / 4" of positive ease.

PATTERN INFORMATION

This top is a fun project that works up quickly. It is made up of four panels worked bottom-up, shaping the shoulders to achieve the neckline.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

sc (blo) = single crochet back loop only

hdc = half double crochet

hdc (blo) = half double crochet back loop only

puff + 1ch + puff = 1puff stitch + 1 chain + 1puff stitch in the same stitch

tr = treble crochet

dc = double crochet

3tr shell = 3 treble crochet in the same stitch

st st = slip stitch

sk = skip

st (s) = stitch (es)

rep = repeat

RS / WS = right side / wrong side

* to * = repeat the instructions between * *

INFO AND TIPS

- You can modify the length of the garment or the sleeves by repeating from rows (7, 7, 9) (9, 13, 13) to rows (14, 14, 16) (16, 20, 20).
- The turning chains always count as a stitch.
- The main pattern always has the same number of stitches as in the starting chain of the panels.
- Check the stitches on row (10, 10, 12) (12, 16, 16) and on row (14, 14, 16) (16, 20, 20).



How to work hdc (blo):

Work hdc only on the back loop as shown in the photos. The first photo indicates the loop that needs to be worked on.







How to work puff + 1 ch + puff:

Make 3 unfinished hdc in the same stitch and close all together, ch to close the stitch, another separating chain and again 3 unfinished hdc in the same stitch and close all together and ch to close the stitch.





















How to work 3 tr shell

Make a double yarn over, insert the hook and yarn out two rings at a time, so you have the first treble crochet, make 2 more tr in the same stitch.

















How to work 1dc between puffs

Work in the hole shown in the photos.







MAIN PATTERN Front and back panels (make two alike)

Row 1: RS, (66, 72, 78) (84, 90, 96) ch, starting in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each ch to end. (65, 71, 77) (83, 89, 95) sts. 2 ch, turn.



Row 2: WS, hdc to the end. 2ch, turn.





Row 3 - (6, 6, 8) (8, 12, 12): hdc (blo) until the end. 3 ch, turn.





Row (7, 7, 9) (9, 13, 13): RS, sk 1st, puff + 1 ch + puff, *1 ch, sk 2 sts, 1 dc, 1 ch, sk 2 sts, puff + 1 ch + puff*. Rep * to * to the last 2 sts, sk 1 st, 1dc in last st. 4 ch, turn.



Row (8, 8, 10) (10, 14, 14): WS, sk 1st, 1 dc between puffs, *2 ch, sk 2 sts, 1 dc over the dc of the previous row, 2 ch, sk 2 sts, 1 dc between puffs*. Rep * to * to the last 2 sts, 1 ch, sk 1st, 1 dc in last st (3rd ch up from previous round). 4ch, turn





Row (9, 9, 11) (11, 15, 15): RS, sk 1st, 3 tr shell over the dc of the previous row, *1 ch, 1 tr over the dc of the previous row, 1 ch, 3 tr shell over the dc of the previous row*. Rep * to * to last 2 sts, sk 1 st, tr in last st. 1ch, turn.



Row (10, 10, 12) (12, 16, 16): WS, sc to end. 4 ch, turn.



Row (11, 11, 13) (13, 17, 17): RS, sk 1 st, 1 dc, 1 ch, *sk 2 sts, puff + 1 ch + puff, 1ch, sk 2 sts, 1 dc, 1 ch* Rep *to* to the last 2 sts, sk 1st, 1dc in last st. 4 ch, turn.





Row (12, 12, 14) (14, 18, 18): WS, sk 1 st, 1 dc over the dc of the previous row, *2 ch, 1 dc between puffs of the previous row, 2ch, 1 dc over dc from previous row*. Rep *to* to the last 2 sts, 1 ch, sk 1 st, 1 dc in last st. 5 ch, turn.



Row (13, 13, 15) (15, 19, 19): RS, sk 1 st, 1tr over the dc of previous row, 1 ch, *sk 2 sts, 3 tr shell over the dc of previous row,, 1 ch, sk 2 sts, 1 tr over the dc of previous row, 1ch* Rep *to* to the last 2 sts, sk 1 st, 1 tr in last st. 1 ch, turn.



Row (14, 14, 16) (16, 20, 20): WS, sc until the end of the row. Remember to make sc in the 4th and 5th ch of rise. 4 ch, turn.





Row (15, 15, 17) (17, 21, 21) - (30, 30, 32) (32, 36, 36) Rep 2 times from row (7, 7, 9) (9, 13, 13) until row (14, 14, 16) (16, 20, 20). 2 ch, turn

Row (31, 31, 33) (33, 37, 37) - (35, 35, 37) (37, 41, 41): hdc (blo) until the end of the row. 2ch, turn.

Shoulders

On back panel

Row 1: hdc (blo) until the end of the row. 2ch, turn.

Row 2: (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) hdc (blo), ch 2, turn leaving the rest of the sts unworked (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) sts.

Row 3: hdc (blo) to end (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) sts. Finish off

Count (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) sts from the other end of your piece and join the thread in the same st.

Row 2 - 3: ch 2, hdc (blo) to end (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) sts. Finish off.





On the front panel

Row 1: (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) hdc (blo), 2 ch, turn leaving the rest of the sts unworked (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) sts.

Row 2-3: hdc (blo) to the end (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) sts. Finish off

Count (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) sts from the other end of your piece and join the thread in the same st.

Row 1 - 3: 2 ch (count as stitch), hdc (blo) to end (18, 19, 21) (23, 26, 29) sts. 2 ch, turn. Finish off

Sleeves (make two)

Row 1: RS, (66, 66, 66) (72, 72, 78) ch, starting in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each ch to end. (65, 65, 65) (71, 71, 77) sts. 2 ch, turn.

Repeat rows 2 - (22, 22, 24) (24, 28, 28) of the main pattern.



SEWING

Sew the shoulders. Then divide the sleeve panel in half and attach the openwork part to the shoulder seam and body. Finally, sew the sleeves and sides of the body.







Neck finish (worked in the round)

Work the neck with the RS up. Join the thread in the center of the back.

Round 1: 1 ch (does not count as st), sc throughout round, join with sl st.

Round 2: 1 ch (does not count as st), sc (blo) throughout the round, join with sl st. Finish off.
