#### **MATERIALS**

2 skeins of **Dancing Queen** col. 08

Crochet hook 6 mm (US J/10) Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US F) Magnetic button

# **YARN QUALITY**

**Dancing Queen**, Hobbii 100 % polyester 180 g (6.3 oz) = 55 m (60 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

11 single crochet x 10 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

#### SIZE

One size

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Length: 23 cm / 9" Height: 12 cm / 4.7"

Width of the base: 7 cm / 2.75"

# **Pattern**







**Base of the bag** 

With 6mm crochet hook Chain 22.

Row 1-6: Single crochet all stitches. Remember to chain 1 every end of the row, before turning.

#### **Front Panel**

Row 7: Slip stitch in only the back loop to the end of the row, chain 1, turn.

Row 8-10: Single crochet all stitches through both loops like normal to the end of the row. Chain 1, turn.

Row 11: Skip one stitch, single crochet into each stitch until 2 stitches left, skip the next stitch, single crochet into the last one. Chain 1, turn.

Row 12-13: Single crochet into all stitches. Chain 1, turn.

Row 14: Repeat row 11.

Row 15-16: Repeat row 12-13.

Row 17: Repeat row 11.

Cut the yarn off.

#### **Back Panel**

Attach the yarn to the other side of your base. Start on the **left side of the row**, on the **wrong side of the project**. Holding the base of the bag further from yourself. The easiest way to tell which is the right side is by checking which side has this border.

Row 1: Single crochet into all stitches. Chain 1, turn.

Row 2: Slip stitch into front loops only till the end of the row, chain 1, turn.

Row 3: Repeat instructions from the **Front Panel** row 8-17. Don't mind the row number, that corresponds only to the front panel, because we counted rows with the base. You are now on row 3 instead of row 8.

Row 13-14: Single crochet all stitches. Chain 1, turn.

Row 15: Skip one stitch, single crochet into each stitch until 1 stitch left. Chain 1, turn.

Row 16-17: Repeat row 13-14.

Row 18: Repeat row 15.

Row 19-20: Repeat row 13-14.

Row 21: Repeat row 15. Cut the yarn.

#### **Sides & Handles**

Chain 7, turn

Row 1-2: Single crochet all, chain 1, turn.

Row 3: Single crochet 2, skip 1, single crochet 3. Chain 1, turn.

Row 4-5: Repeat row 1-2.

Row 6: Single crochet 2, skip 1, single crochet 2. Chain 1, turn.



Row 7-45: Single crochet all, chain 1, turn.

Row 46: Single crochet 1, 2 single crochet in next stitch, single crochet remaining stitches. Chain 1, turn.

Row 47-48: Repeat row 1-2.

Row 49: Repeat row 46. Do not cut the yarn off.

#### **Attaching pieces**

Take a 3.5mm crochet hook. Place the project wrong side up, shorter side closer to you. Align the base of the handle with the base of the bag on the right side. Single crochet through both bases, holding the project right side up. Continue single crocheting through both bases forward



Move onto the side of the bag, single crochet through both pieces until you reach row 10 of your handle.

Slip stitch only into the bag piece, around. See picture below.



Once you have reached row 10 of the bag body, counting from the base edge. Single crochet through both the handle and the bag body once again. Continue around, through the base of the bag and to the front of the bag, stop once you reach the top of the front panel.



Single crochet across the front panel, until you reach the other corner. See picture below.



Single crochet the body of the bag and the handle together, starting from row 10 of the handle. Cut the yarn off, weave in the ends.

Now attach yarn to the bottom of the handle. Crochet the two sides of the handle together. See the picture below.



Cut the yarn off, weave in the ends.

## Attach the magnet

Take a thread in matching color, sew the magnet in the middle, on row 3 of the bag flap and the bag front. See the picture below.





Weave in all those loose ends. Make sure to tie an extra knot or two. And enjoy your newly made bag!
